4-11-13<sup>3</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey William Antongeorgi III met with the stewards for a review of the second race from Sunday, April 7, 2013.

Mr. Antongeorgi was questioned about his ride on #4 HOT LIST (Trainer Sergio Ledezma). The veteran rider stated the three year old filly was hard to handle and could not handle the track. This was the filly's first attempt on the turf and was pulled up on the backstretch.

Trainer Ledezma indicated the filly is difficult to control and was informed she must work 5/8 before re-entering.

4-11-13<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 48 OWNER ERIC WAYNE SWAIN (13GG032) & RULING NO. 49 RACHEL MARIE SWAIN (13GG032)**

Owner **ERIC WAYNE SWAIN d.b.a. SWAIN RACING INC.**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Sunday, April 7, 2013, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

Owner **RACHEL MARIE SWAIN d.b.a. SWAIN RACING INC.**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Sunday, April 7, 2013, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

The foregoing rulings were issued as the Swain's failed to appear for a scheduled hearing regarding the financial complaint filed against them by San Francisco Equine, Inc. alleging a delinquent account for veterinary services totaling \$2885.00.

4-12-13<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 50 – STEVE MIYADI**

Trainer **STEVE J. MIYADI** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for failure to have the foal certificate for the horse OUGHT TO WIN on file in the racing office necessitating a late scratch in the fifth race on Thursday, April 11, 2013; a violation of California Horse Racing

Board rule #1588 (c) (Horse Ineligible to Start in a Race).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Miyadi accepted responsibility for not having the foal certificate for his horse OUGHT TO WIN on file by race day.

4-12-13<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 51 – DEMESIO FLORES CAMACHO (13GG030)**

Exercise Rider Demesio Flores Camacho is fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)\* and placed on probation for the term of his license (10-31-13) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Intoxication) on March 16, 2013. As a condition of probation Mr. Camacho must abide by the terms of a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Camacho met with the stewards regarding a Security report indicating Mr. Camacho was intoxicated and driving erratically in the parking lot the evening of March 16, 2013.

Mr. Camacho, who has a spotless California Horse Racing Board record, was very remorseful and does understand a repeat performance could jeopardize his license.

4-12-13<sup>5</sup> **ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – 6<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the sixth race to review an incident at the start.

#7 SENJEN (Jockey – Kerwin John) stumbled leaving the gate and unseated her rider. No other horses were involved.

Jockey Kerwin John was not injured, nor was the four year old filly SENJEN (Trainer – James Kasparoff).

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the third race to review an accident in the stretch.

#7 DONTMESSWITHKITTEN (Jockey – Juan Hernandez) ducked in near the 1/8 pole and crashed through the rail during this one mile and one sixteenth turf event. No other horses were involved.

Jockey Hernandez was not seriously injured, but was excused from his remaining mounts. DONTMESSWITHKITTEN (Trainer – Blaine Wright) suffered only scratches and slight bruising and will be placed on the Stewards List.

4-13-13<sup>4</sup> **ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – 6<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the sixth race for a review of an accident that occurred soon after the start of this six furlong event.

#1 GOLDEN CHILD (Jockey – Frank Alvarado) ducked in after leaving the starting gate and broke through the inside rail extension coming out of the six furlong chute, unseating Jockey Alvarado. No other horses were involved.

Jockey Alvarado was not injured and fulfilled his remaining engagements. GOLDEN CHILD (Trainer – O.J. Jauregui) was not injured and will be placed on the Stewards List.

4-13-13<sup>5</sup> **FILL IN STEWARD**

Steward Darrel McHargue was called away on a family emergency and was replaced by Safety Steward Paul Nicolo for the afternoon program.

**Sunday**4-14-13<sup>1</sup> **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The Cal bred race for three year old fillies, claiming \$30,000- 32,000, one mile and one sixteenth, failed to fill.

4-14-13<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 52 – JOHN SADLER (13GG018)**

Trainer **John Sadler**, who started the horse CATRAGEOUS, winner of the third race at Golden Gate Fields on February 3, 2013, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Flunixin – in excess of permitted level 36.1 ng/ml [Class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Sadler was granted a telephone hearing regarding this complaint alleging a flunixin (banamine) violation.

Mr. Sadler, who has a respectable medication record, acknowledged he is responsible as trainer of record, but has no idea how this incident occurred.

The veteran trainer sent his horse, CATRAGEOUS, from Santa Anita to Golden Gate Fields with a responsible groom, to run in the third race on February 3, 2013. The horse was not to be treated with flunixin. Mr. Sadler requested the split sample test and Industrial Laboratories confirmed the original finding.

Mr. Sadler accepted the penalty imposed.
