5-15-13¹ **ENTRIES AND DECLARATIONS**

Steward John Herbuveaux was in attendance today to oversee entries for Saturday and declarations for tomorrow. Mr. Herbuveaux will continue with those duties for the remainder of the week.

5-16-13¹ **CAL BRED REPORT**

Purse \$23,000. For California bred or California sired three year olds, claiming \$25,000 at six furlongs. The race was called off with no entries.

5-16-13² **TRAINER JOHN F. MARTIN – RULING NO. 69**

Trainer **JOHN F. MARTIN**, who worked the horse **GATHERATTHEALTER**, for removal from the Veterinarian's list at Golden Gate Fields on December 7, 2012, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rules #1843 (a) & (d) 9Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level, 2.46 ug/mc [Class 4]) and #1866 (d) (Veterinarian's List).

The foregoing ruling was issued after the Stewards received a copy of the stipulated agreement between Mr. Martin and the Board.

5-17-13²**MOGER JR. MEDICATION WARNING**

Trainer Ed Moger Jr. was issued a warning which resolves complaint #13GG042. Mr. Moger Jr. was cited after one of his horses, COST OF FREEDOM, which raced on April 6, 2013 post race tested with an overage of Phenylbutazone level of 2.9ug/ml. His licensing record was clear of any medication violation for the previous two years which placed the penalty in California Horse Racing Board rule 1843.3 Category D.

5-17-13³**GREGORY D. UNRUH, D.B.A. UNITY HOLDING LLC****RULING NO. 70**

GREGORY D. UNRUH, D.B.A. UNITY HOLDINGS LLC, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before May 16, 2013, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Unruh failed to appear to address California Horse Racing Board complaint #13GG047 in which he was cited for allegedly failing to pay a veterinary debt of \$456.23 owed to San Francisco Equine Inc.

5-17-13⁴ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION (2ND RACE)**

Following the running of the second race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of contact between #4 EVERYBODY KNOWS (4th place – jockey Dennis Carr) and #6 INDIAN BOBBY (6th place- jockey Julien Couton) near the eighth mile marker.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the incident, #4 EVERYBODY KNOWS was disqualified from 4th to 6th.

The recordings show #4 shift outward, for racing room, from behind the leaders and make contact with #6, forcing that rival off its path then continue to drift out while bumping and impeding with #6. The decision was unanimous.

5-17-13⁵ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION (7TH RACE)**

After the running of the 7th race the inquiry sign was lit once again for a review of an observed incident near the eighth mile pole involving #10 SOUTH FORTY (4th place – jockey Pedro Terrero) and #3 AUTISM AWAKENESS (6th place – jockey Freddy Rodriguez).

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recordings of the incident, #10 SOUTH FORTY was disqualified from 4th to 6th.

The recordings show the rider of #3 check sharply and lose position after #10 drifts inward into that rival's path causing #3 to lose all chance of a better placing. The decision was a majority vote with Steward Nevin casting a dissenting vote.

Purse \$10,000. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares three years old and upward, claiming \$5,000 at six furlongs. The race was called off with five entries.

5-18-13² **JOCKEY DENNIS CARR & JOCKEY PEDRO TERRERO RULINGS****RULING NO. 71**

Jockey **DENNIS CARR**, who rode **EVERYBODY KNOWS** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, May 17, 2013 is suspended three (3) racing days (May 25, 26, and 27 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

RULING NO. 72

Jockey **PEDRO TERRERO**, who rode **SOUTH FORTY** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, May 17, 2013 is suspended three (3) racing days (May 25, 26, and 27 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to sixth.

A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The rulings listed above were issued after both riders reviewed their race and acknowledged going too far before making corrections when they allowed their mounts to drift off course and cause interference.

5-19-13¹ **CAL BRED REPORT**
Purse \$12,000. For California bred or California sired three year olds and upward, claiming \$8,000 at one mile and one sixteenth. Only one entry was made for the race and the race was called off.

5-19-13² **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 8th RACE**
Following the running of the 8th race the inquiry sign was lit for a review of contact near the 1/8 pole between #2 THIS ONE'S FOR MEL (2nd place – jockey Christian Santiago Reyes) and #3 TIZ FITTING (5th place – jockey Juan Hernandez).

An objection was also lodged by Mr. Hernandez against #2 THIS ONE'S FOR MEL for the same incident.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recordings of the incident #2 was Disqualified from 2nd and placed 5th.

The recordings show #2 drift out through the stretch and make contact with #3. #3 was bumped off stride, lost position and lost any chance of a better placing. The decision was unanimous.
