5-31-13³ **HENDERSON RULING**

RULING #78

Trainer **FRANCES HENDERSON** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty For Late Declaration) for not having the horse BRASS ANGEL properly shod necessitating a late scratch in the fifth race on Monday, May 27, 2013; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required).

The above ruling was issued after Henderson participated in a telephone hearing and accepted responsibility for the incident. A lack of communication between Henderson and her foreman led to the horse's arrival at the Receiving Barn without rear shoes when such information was not declared at time of entry.

5-31-13⁴ **CLAIM VOID – SECOND RACE**

A claim for #3 LEGAL VICTORY was voided after Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin reported the horse was lame in the left hind and was placed on the Veterinarian's List.

6-1-13² **SLOAN HEARING**

An informal hearing was held for trainer Nick Sloan who was named in a complaint after the horse LUSCIOUS LONNA showed the presence of Dantrolene in a post race test sample on April 7, 2013. The substance is a Class 4 muscle relaxant which Sloan used to treat the horse for tying up. Sloan stated he stopped administration of the prescribed medication 72 hours prior to the race but apparently the withdrawal time was insufficient to prevent detection or the dosage was given closer to race time. Decision to follow.

SLOAN RULING

RULING #79

Trainer **NICK SLOAN**, who started the horse LUSCIOUS LONNA, winner of the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on April 7, 2013, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Ensure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Unapproved Substance – Dantrolene [Class 4]).

STEWARDS INQUIRY – FOURTH RACE – DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the start involving #1 VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL (2nd – jockey Dennis Carr) and #2 RIBOT BELLE (unplaced – jockey Abel Cedillo) after contact between the two was observed. Following a thorough review the Stewards disqualified RIBOT BELLE from second and declared that horse unplaced by putting him behind VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL.

Tapes of the race showed that VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL broke out sharply at the start and made contact with RIBOT BELLE who was pulled up at the 4 ½ shortly after the two came together. Cedillo stated his horse took a bad step after the contact and he pulled the horse up out of an abundance of caution.

CLAIMS VOIDED
