Trainer **GARY U. EICKERMAN**, who started the horse MAHMOUD MEMORY, seventh place finisher in the seventh race at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on August 18, 2013, is fined the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Flunixin: in excess of permitted level- 104 ng/ml [Class 4]).

The aforementioned ruling was issued after this Board reviewed the evidence presented at hearing on 12/1/13⁵.

After reviewing all of the recorded views and listening to his explanation, by majority vote he was given a warning. Steward McHargue was of the opinion a suspension was in order.

ALBERT M. LENZINI – RULING NO.40

Trainer **ALBERT M. LENZINI**, who started the horse FRENCH DYNASTY, winner of the tenth race at the Fresno District Fair on October 6, 2013, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars

(\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: more than one approved substance: Phenylbutazone & Flunixin [Class 4]).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Lenzini met with this Board, waived his rights to a hearing and pled guilty with an explanation. Mr. Lenzini stated that he follows the same procedures of administering these two medications to all his horses and for some unknown reason this horse failed to metabolize the drugs at the same rate as the other horses. He also stated he will allow more time in the future between administrations and race times to ensure compliance with the rule.
