On Sunday, December 8, 2013, the claim submitted for MADDIE MOO in the eighth race by Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, was voided as State Vet Forrest Franklin, DVM reported the two year old filly was unsound and placed on the Vets list. MADDIE MOO was returned to Clifford DeLima's barn.

Two claims were voided today after Dr. Franklin reported the horses were unsound and placed on the Vet's List. POSSE POWER was returned to the Frank Lucarelli barn following the third race for being unsound and BOBGEEPERS was returned to Jerry Hollendorfer's barn following the sixth race, unsound.

12-13-13³ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 2ND RACE**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the second race for a review of the stretch run involving #4 MARK A STAR (Jockey – Juan Hernandez) second and #9 BILBAO (Jockey – Diego Sanchez) who finished fourth.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #4 MARK A STAR from second to fourth.

The video shows #4 MARK A STAR, while being guided out from behind horses, bore out from a left handed whip, bumped and impeded #9 BILBAO near the 1/16 pole, preventing the latter from finishing where she might had the incident not occurred.

RULING NO.41 - OWNER SHAWN MARCIA KENNEDY (13GG0149)

Owner **SHAWN MARCIA KENNEDY**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before December 13, 2013, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

The above ruling was issued as Ms. Kennedy failed to appear for a hearing regarding a financial complaint filed against her by Trainer Steven Howard alleging an overdue training bill totaling \$19,655.78.

12-14-13⁴

RULING NO.42 – JOCKEY JUAN HERNANDEZ

Jockey **JUAN HERNANDEZ** who rode **MARK A STAR** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday December 13, 2013 is suspended seven (7) racing days (December 27, 28, 29, 2013, January 1, 2, 3 and 4, 2014) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to fourth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules Careless Riding).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Hernandez and the Stewards reviewed the video of the second race.

Mr. Hernandez acknowledged he erred when he angled out around horses and bumped and impeded a rival.

The seven day suspension was imposed as this is Mr. Hernandez' third infraction within the last sixty days.

12-14-13⁵ **PEGGIE C. HANFORD (13GG0139)**

A formal hearing was held this morning for Ms. Hanford, who has been charged with alleged violations of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a) (d), #1887 (a) and #1859.5.

Present for the hearing, in addition to the Stewards, were Ms. Hanford, Owner Juan Moya, California Horse Racing Board Investigators Mike Bridges and Louis Quezada, who presented the case. CSR Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

According to the complaint the official urine sample #F10910 taken on October 6, 2013 at the Fresno County Fair from the horse "WILLIE DASHER" contained 974 pg/ml of Clenbuterol. "WILLIE DASHER" finished first in the second race on October 6, 2013. Ms. Hanford was the trainer of record and Mr. Moya is the owner. The hearing was concluded after oral and documentary evidence was presented.

12-14-13⁶ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – FIRST RACE**

The Stewards posted the Objection sign following the first race at the request of Jockey Abel Cedillo who finished third on #5 MIZ STRAWBERRY DEE. Mr. Cedillo lodged a claim of foul against #8 GLOBAL WARMING (Jockey – Russell Baze) the winner, alleging interference in the stretch.

After interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official. The video shows MIZ STRAWBERRY DEE (Jockey – Abel Cedillo) actually initiated the minor contract.

12-14-13⁷ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – FOURTH RACE**

The Objection sign was posted as Jockey Jorge Espitia, who rode #11 JIMMENY CREEK (fifth) lodged a claim of foul against #12 TARAMO (jockey –Isaias Enriquez), the winner.

After checking the Patrol Judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make no change in the original order of finish as there was nothing to warrant a disqualification.

RULING NO.43 – REFER 12-14-13⁵ (Hanford)

Acting on a report from the University of California at Davis Maddy Laboratories, the official Laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that the post race urine sample #F10910 taken from the horse WILLIE DASHER, winner of the second race at the Fresno District Fair on Sunday, October 6, 2013 contained the unapproved substance Clenbuterol, it is hereby ordered that WILLIE DASHER be disqualified from all purse monies earned and deemed unplaced in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$4,450.00) earned or awarded to owner Juan H. Moya, trainer Peggie Hanford and jockey Cruz Mendez be returned to the Paymaster of Purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1st – Z BEST CONTENDER
- 2nd – TRANS SONIC
- 3rd – EL KORITA
- 4th – ALL JOCK

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.

The Stewards issued the foregoing ruling as a result of the formal hearing held yesterday (12/14/13) regarding the positive test (Clenbuterol) result on the urine taken from WILLIE DASHER following the second race at the Fresno County Fair on Sunday, October 6, 2013.
