INQUIRY – OBJECTION – 6th RACE

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the sixth race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #1 INTERFERONS CIM (Jockey – William Antongeorgi III) first and #3 WILDCAT CANDY (Jockey – Russell Baze) third. Jockey Baze also lodged a claim of foul regarding the same incident.

After interviewing the riders, considering the Patrol Judges report and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows #1 INTERFERONS CIM drifts out inside the 1/16 pole into the path of #3 WILDCAT CANDY, causing the latter to steady briefly and alter course. The Stewards determined the incident did not affect the outcome.

RULING #7 – JOCKEY WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI III

Jockey **WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI III** who rode **INTERFERONS CIM** in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, January 4, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (January 12, 16 and 17, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Antongeorgi and the Stewards reviewed the video of the sixth race from January 4, 2014.

Mr. Antongeorgi III stated he was unaware there was a horse on his heels when he drifted out near the finish.

The veteran rider admitted he erred by letting his horse drift and not looking to see if he was clear.

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – 7th RACE

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the seventh race for a review of two incidents in the stretch involving #3 POWER OF TEN (Jockey – Ricardo Gonzalez) first and #9 SUDDEN SUNDAY (Jockey – Russell Baze) second.

After conferring with the Patrol Judges, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows #9 SUDDEN SUNDAY drifting out coming into the stretch causing #3 POWER OF TEN to go wide. The second incident occurred near the finish when POWER OF TEN stepped in and bumped SUDDEN SUNDAY.
