**CANDELARIO VILLAMAR (CASE #14GG0015)**

Candelario Villamar, now licensed as an Owner and Assistant Trainer, appeared before the Stewards to address a financial complaint filed against him by Equine Sports Medicine and Surgery (Jerry Parker, DVM). The complaint alleges Mr. Villamar owes \$4,480.07 for services rendered. Mr. Villamar and Dr. Parker excused themselves for the purpose of negotiating a settlement. They returned with a payment agreement that calls for three hundred dollar monthly payments until a total of \$2500.00 is paid.

03-06-14<sup>4</sup> **RULING #35 – GARY E. GREINER (REFER 3-2-14<sup>5</sup>)**

Association Employee **GARY E. GREINER** is fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to perform his duties in a proper manner on Sunday, March 2, 2014 (second offense).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Greiner met with the Stewards regarding his failure to operate his camera (3/8 tower) for the running of the third race on Sunday, March 02, 2014. Mr. Greiner apologized saying he fell asleep.

03-06-14<sup>5</sup> **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 2<sup>ND</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the second race for a review of the stretch run. Jockey Barrington Harvey (#1 TANNED MISTRESS) fifth, subsequently lodged a claim of foul against #5 BLACK MISCHIEF (Jockey- Isaias Enriquez) fourth.

After interviewing the riders involved, checking patrol judges report and reviewing The video, the Stewards, by a majority vote decision (McHargue dissented), disqualified #5 BLACK MISCHIEF from fourth to fifth.

The video shows #5 BLACK MISCHIEF angles in behind the leaders near the 1/8 pole and into the path of #1 TANNED MISTRESS, causing the latter to clip heels and all chance at a better placing.

03-07-14<sup>3</sup> **RULING #36 – JOCKEY ISAIAS ENRIQUEZ**

Jockey **ISAIAS ENRIQUEZ** who rode **BLACK MISCHIEF** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, March 6, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (March 14, 15 and 16, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to fifth place; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Enriquez and the Stewards reviewed the

video of the second race from March 6, 2014. Mr. Enriquez' mount, BLACK MISCHIEF, was disqualified from fourth to fifth for causing interference in the stretch. The veteran rider was very candid in acknowledging he erred by not looking to see if he was clear before altering his course into the path of a rival. The Stewards decided, unanimously, that a penalty was warranted.

03-07-14<sup>4</sup>**CLAIM VOID – FIRST RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer Rod Cone for the four year old filly FORBIDDEN KEE, who finished third in the first race. Mr. Cone's claim slip read FORBIDDEN KEY. The filly went to the successful claimant trainer Michael Lenzini.

03-07-14<sup>5</sup>**INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – 6<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the sixth race for a review of two separate incidents.

#5 CELLOPHANE (Jockey- Alejandro Gomez) went wrong and unseated her jockey near the 3/16 pole. Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer reported the five year old mare fractured her left front ankle and was euthanized on the track. Jockey Gomez, although not seriously injured, was excused from his remaining mounts.

Prior to the aforementioned accident #8 TOUGH ORPHAN was pulled up by Jockey Pedro Terrero near the 1/2 mile pole. The Veterinarian reported the four year old Filly was unsound in the right hind leg. Accident report is attached.

03-07-14<sup>6</sup>**INQUIRY – 7<sup>th</sup> RACE – NO CHANGE**

The Stewards conducted an Inquiry following the seventh race to review an incident inside the 1/16 pole involving #1 TIME TO GLOW (Jockey – Catalino Martinez) second and #10 SOUL INTENT (Jockey- Isaias Enriquez) third.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards, in a majority decision (Nevin dissenting) made no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows #1 TIME TO GLOW drifts out, under left handed whipping, into the path of #10 SOUL INTENT impeding the progress of the latter. The majority opined the incident did not deny SOUL INTENT the opportunity of a better placing.

**RULING NO.37 – JOCKEY CATALINO MARTINEZ**

Jockey **CATALINO MARTINEZ**, who rode **TIME TO GLOW** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on March 7, 2014, is suspended three (3) racing days (March 15, 16 and 20, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Martinez and the Stewards reviewed the video of the seventh race from March 7, 2014.

Mr. Martinez admitted he erred by continuing to whip left handed while his mount was drifting out and causing interference. The Stewards decided unanimously that a suspension was warranted.

**TOTE PROBLEM**

The Stewards were notified by Tote Manager Tony Lovell that he inadvertently deleted from the wagering format, #5 SALAH CHAMP, from the fifth race instead of #5 FULL INSTINCT from the eighth race.

Mr. Lovell indicated this error occurred at 12:16.00p.m. and was corrected at 12:16.40p.m. with no wagers refused on #5 SALAH CHAMP (5<sup>th</sup> race) during that brief span.

The Stewards reviewed the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1974 (Wagering Interest) and since no wagers were refused we decided, unanimously, to allow #5 SALAH CHAMP to remain as a wagering interest.

A letter of explanation and a report from Tote is attached.

After interviewing the riders involved, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided, unanimously, to make no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows Mr., Enriquez' mount, DUCHESS DEBBIE, in the middle of a three horse spread, step out and initiate the contact with the hind end of #4 IHAVETOGO.
