08-16-14³ **FINANCIAL COMPLAINT – FRANK & THOMAS VONFLUE (14GG0074)**

A formal hearing was held to address a financial complaint filed by Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer against owners Frank and Thomas VonFlue., alleging an overdue training debt. Assistant Trainer Janet Hollendorfer represented her husband. After a lengthy discussion and some venting on both sides, the parties agreed to a payment plan to satisfy the entire debt (\$8600.00).

08-16-14⁴ **DELAY – 5th RACE**

There was a ten minute delay for the start of the fifth race as #9 SWISS WAGER (Frank Alvarado) lost a shoe in the post parade. The two year old gelding was returned to the paddock and Horseshoe Inspector Jack Hammonds was summoned from the Receiving Barn to replace the shoe. The riders for the rest of the field dismounted while the repair work was accomplished,

SWISS WAGER went on to win the \$25,000.00 maiden claiming event.

08-16-14⁵ **STEWARDS REVIEW – 7th RACE**

The Stewards conducted a review of the stretch run to allow the public the opportunity to watch with them a non disqualifying incident near the finish. The incident involved the winner #7 REDSTONE (Juan Hernandez) and #6 TIZ THE SEASON (Kyle Frey), who finished second.

The video shows #6 TIZ THE SEASON drifts out approaching the finish and initiates the slight contact with the winner. Therefore, no inquiry or disqualification was necessary.

08-16-14⁶ **FILLY GOES WRONG – 8th RACE**

#5 ZUNI TUNES (Pedro Terrero) was eased down the stretch and pulled up shortly after the finish. Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer reported the three year old filly was unsound in both forelegs and summoned the horse ambulance to give the filly a ride

back to Trainer Victor Trujillo's barn.

08-17-14³ **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Kyle Frey met with the Stewards for a review of the seventh race from August 16, 2014. Mr. Frey was cautioned about allowing his mount to drift in late stretch and was issued a warning.

08-17-14⁴ **JOCKEY'S RIDING FEE**

Paymaster of Purses Pat Prospero has informed the Board of Stewards that Pacific Racing Association will not only comply with a California Horse Racing Board directive to increase by 12 ½ % the losing jockey fee for races of less than ten thousand (\$10,000.00) but will also raise the fee 12 ½% for the second and third place finishers for those races.

08-17-14⁵ **TRAINER OBJECTION – 4th RACE – NO CHANGE**

The Stewards posted the Objection sign following the fourth race at the request of Trainer Sam DiLaura (#4 ANTE A PENNY – second), who lodged a claim of foul against the winner #1 RANGER MARINI (Russell Baze). Mr. DiLaura alleged RANGER MARINI interfered with his horse as the field came out of the infield chute for this one mile and one sixteenth turf event.

After considering the Patrol Judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows #3 ALL MAGIC (Catalino Martinez) fourth drifts slightly coming out of the chute, causing #1 RANGER MARINI to drift out and in turn, forces #4 ANTE A PENNY out as well. The incident was minor and since #3 ALL MAGIC finished fourth, no action was necessary.

08-17-14⁶ **STEWARDS REVIEW – 5th RACE**

The Stewards instructed the track announcer, Michael Wrona, to inform the betting public that we were reviewing the start. #6 FINDING FORESTRY (Juan Hernandez) was off to a very slow, but fair start.

08-17-14⁷ **CLAIM VOIDED – 8th RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by Trainer John Martin for #4 FORDHAM

ROAD after State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM reported the horse was unsound in the right foreleg and was placed on the Veterinarian's List. Fordham Road was returned to the Steve Sherman barn.
