RULING #4 – TRAINER ED MOGER JR.

Trainer **ED MOGER JR.**, who started the horse LADY LIONHEART, second place finisher in the fourth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on July 30, 2014, is fined the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for viola-

tion of CHRB Rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Flunixin, in excess of permitted level, 259 ng/ml [Class 4]).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Moger accepted responsibility for the high Flunixin, but cannot explain how the horse received the apparent race day treatment.

The veteran trainer surmised this horse received a treatment intended for another horse in his barn.

10-23-14⁴ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – 5th RACE**

The Stewards posted the Objection sign following the fifth race at the request of jockey Kyle Frey (#5 – TWOLUCKSTOWIN – second) who lodged a claim of foul against #7 CATATONIC CAT (Catalino Martinez – third).

After interviewing the riders and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to disallow the claim of foul. The video does not substantiate the alleged interference.

Trainer **SHELDON W. PALDANIUS**, who started the horse I B MIKE, winner of the fifth race at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on June 26, 2014, is fined the sum of five dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB Rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: prohibited substance – Methocarbamol [Class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Paldanius accepted responsibility for the presence of Methocarbamol as he had treated I B MIKE days before the race on June

26, 2014.

CLAIM VOIDED – 6TH RACE

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer Bill McLean for the gelding TRICKY SHANE, the winner of the sixth race. Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer Reported TRICKY SHANE pulled up unsound and was given a ride home in the horse ambulance. State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin confirmed the geldings condition and was returned to trainer Victor Trujillo's barn.

GENARO ORNELAS VALLEJO (CASE 14GG0057)

A formal hearing was held for trainer Genaro Vallejo, who has been charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules #1843 (a) and (d), #1843.1 (b), #1844 (c) and #1887 (a).

Present for the hearing, in addition to Steward John Herbuveaux, Darrel McHargue, Dennis Nevin and Safety Steward Vic Stauffer, were Mr. Vallejo, his Veterinarian Kim Kuhlman, D.V.M. and CHRB Investigator Louis Quezada. who presented the case. C.S.R. Christine Niccolo transcribed the proceedings.

According to the complaint, "the official blood sample #GG19496 taken on May 16, 2014 at Golden Gate Fields was reported to contain 0.52 ug/ml of Phenylbutazone And 5.9 ng/ml of Flunixin. This sample was obtained from the horse VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL which ran in the third race at Golden Gate Fields finishing third. The trainer of record is Genaro Ornelas Vallejo." The split sample tested by LGC Science, Inc. Laboratories, Lexington, Kentucky, confirmed the presence of Phenylbutazone (0.55ng/ml) and Flunixin (4.2 ng/ml).

After the testimonial and documentary evidence was submitted on the record, the hearing was concluded.

RULING #6 – JAVIER M. LANDEROS

Valet Javier M. Landeros met with the Stewards regarding his repeated tardiness to the saddling paddock. Of more concern was his use of foul and abusive language directed toward the Clerk of Scales when directed to see the Stewards for his latest tardiness.

Clerk of Scales Ken Sjoldal and Paddock Judge Linda Anderson both attested to Mr. Landeros' prior warnings and the latter acknowledged directing the abusive Language toward Mr. Sjoldal.

#7 R U EXPERIENCED (Tr. Don Roberts) went wrong near the 3/8 pole and was Pulled up by jockey Cristobal Herrera. Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer reported the six year old horse was off in the left foreleg and was given a ride home in the horse ambulance.

RULING #7 – GENARO O. VALLEJO (14GG0057)

Owner/Trainer **GENARO O. VALLEJO**, who started the horse VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL, third place finisher in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on May 16, 2014, is suspended thirty (30) days November 1, through November 30, 2014 inclusive and fined the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500.00)*pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB Rules #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances), #1844 (c) (Authorized Medi-

cation) and #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: more than one approved non-steroidal, anti-inflammatory drug substance – Phenylbutazone and Flunixin. [Third class 4 violation in one year along with other aggravating factors].

The foregoing ruling was issued following the formal hearing held on October 25, 2014.
