12-26-14³**INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION**

Following the running of the 2nd race the inquiry sign was posted for a review of interference near the three eighths marker involving (from the outside in) #7 TUPELO CUSH (3rd place- jockey Richard Mitchell), #2 BEV'S FINALE (1st place – jockey Silvio Amador) and #1 ANCIENT MYSTERY (5th place – jockey Leslie Mawing). After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views #7 was disqualified from 3rd to 5th place. The recordings and the information provided by the riders involved placed blame on #7 when it drifted in forcing #2 into the path of #1 and caused the rider of #1 to check his mount and to lose an opportunity if a better placement.

12-26-14⁴**CLAIM VOID – 7TH RACE**

The claim for #3 MICKEY BALL was voided after the Official Veterinarian placed the horse on the Veterinarian's list following the running of the seventh race due to unsoundness. MICKEY BALL was returned to the Jerry Hollendorfer barn.

12-26-14⁵**8TH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION**

Following the running of the eighth race jockey Silvio Amador, rider of #5 IF (4th place) lodged an objection against #3 JACKSON'S A BOBCAT (1st place – jockey Russell Baze) for alleged interference at the head of the stretch.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recordings of the incidents no change was made to the order of finish.

The recordings show the interference was caused by #11 RINGSIDE SEAT (11th place jockey Dionicio Navarro) when that rival drifted out and forced #5 out into #3 and then finished behind those rivals.

Jockey **RICHARD MITCHELL** who rode **TUPELO CUSH** in the Second race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, December 26, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (January 3, 4, and 8, 2015) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a true course around the far turn and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to fifth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding).

RULING NO.02

Jockey **DIONICIO NAVARRO** who rode **RINGSIDE SEAT** in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, December 26, 2014 is suspended three (3) racing days (January 3, 4, and 8, 2015) for

failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding).

The rulings listed above were issued after both riders reviewed their respective races with the Stewards and failed to provide valid reasons for their failure to make the necessary course correction in a timely manner.

NOLAN**, who started the horse LUCY WIGGLES, winner of the third race at Golden Gate Fields on May 8, 2014, is suspended sixty (60) days, January 05 through March 05, 2015 inclusive and is fined the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rules #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rules #1843 (a), (b), (c) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Prohibited Drug Substances – Pseudoephedrine and O-Desmethylpyrilamine, a metabolite of Pyrilamine [Class 3]) and #1890 (a) & (b) (Possession of contraband: needles, syringes and injectable medications).

NO.04

Acting on an order of remand following the adoption of a proposed decision by the California Horse Racing Board, trainer **TERRY M. JOHNSON**, who started the horse GIANNONATTI, third place finisher in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on August 23, 2014, is suspended fifteen (15) days, January 2 through 16, 2015 inclusive and is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a), (b) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Prohibited Drug Substance – Gabapentin [Class 3]).

The foregoing rulings were issued after the California Horse Racing Board remanded the decisions to this Board to issue the rulings.
