01-01-15<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 5<sup>th</sup> PLACE**  
 The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of an incident near the 1/16 pole involving three horses, #4 HANDPICKED BUD (Juan Hernandez) first, #3 WHILLY PINK (Silvio Amador) second and #1 THE SUNOL GRADE (Abel Cedillo) who finished last. The video shows #3 WHILLY PINK drifts in, forcing #1 THE SUNOL GRADE down into #4 HANDPICKED BUD. #1 THE SUNOL GRADE was forced to take back sharply and lose all chance of a better placing. The Board of Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify WHILLY PINK from second to last.

01-01-15<sup>5</sup> **CLAIM VOIDED – 7<sup>th</sup> RACE**  
 The Board of Stewards voided the claim for #5 HUMMING BEETHOVEN by trainer Rod Cone after State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin reported the five year old mare was lame in the left hind leg. The mare was returned to the Steve Sherman barn.

01-02-15<sup>3</sup>**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Silvio Amador met with the Stewards for a review of the fifth race from January 1, 2015. Mr. Amador's mount was disqualified for interference in the stretch and the Stewards are satisfied with the riders effort to control his mount from lugging in during the incident. Mr. Amador was not penalized.

01-02-15<sup>4</sup>**TRAINER FILM REVIEW**

Owner/Trainer Joseph Brook requested a review of yesterday's (1/1/15) fifth race that saw his horse WHILLY PINK disqualified from second to last for interference in the stretch.

Mr. Brook came in with the firm belief that his horse was not responsible for the interference. After a thorough review of all the angles the veteran trainer left agreeing his horse was responsible.

01-02-15<sup>5</sup>**INQUIRY – START – 1<sup>st</sup> RACE**

The Stewards conducted a review of the start as #4 TRIBAL RAIN (Catalino Martinez) did not break with the field. The video shows the five year old mare whips her head as the stall doors open and then stood briefly before leaving the gate. TRIBAL RAIN was determined to be a starter and will be placed on the Starter's List.

01-02-15<sup>6</sup>**ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – 7<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the seventh race for a review of an accident near the 3/8 pole. The video shows #8 GENEROUS GEORGE (Kyle Frey), while racing in tight quarters falls, with #3 MAGESTIC CAT (Pedro Flores) jumping over that horse.

After reviewing all angles the cause was inconclusive. GENEROUS GEORGE either, clipped heels, crossed his own leg or broke down.

Jockey Frey suffered a broken right collarbone, back contusions and a bruised lung. GENEROUS GEORGE was euthanized as he suffered a radial fracture of his left foreleg.
