Pony Person/Association Employee **NATALIE ANN JENNINGS**, having failed to abide by the terms of a signed contract with the Winners Foundation, as required in Pacific Racing Association ruling #77, dated May 30, 2014, is hereby suspended pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards to determine compliance with the terms of probation contained in that ruling.

The above ruling was issued after the Stewards received written notification from Nora Lee of the Winners Foundation that Ms. Jennings has violated the terms of the contract with that organization and therefore the terms of her probation.

01-10-15³**ANTHONY HEARING (CASE #14GG0118)**

Groom Trevor Anthony appeared this morning in response to a complaint filed by Investigator Louis Quezada alleging Anthony was smoking marijuana in his tack room. Nora Lee from the Winners Foundation was also present at Mr. Anthony's request. Investigator Carol Nolan presented the case on behalf of Mr. Quezada.

Anthony admitted to smoking the prohibited substance and stated he would enter into a contract with the Winners Foundation to help insure he will not repeat the offense. The Stewards took the matter under submission and will render a decision tomorrow.

01-11-15² **ANTHONY RULING**

NO.11

Groom **TREVOR W. ANTHONY** is hereby fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)* and placed on probation for the term of his license (04-30-15) for possession and use of marijuana on December 7, 2014; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct).

As a condition of probation Mr. Anthony must sign a testing agreement with the CHRB, submit to an evaluation by the Winners Foundation and agree to abide by any recommendations from that organization. Failure to comply with the terms of probation will result in actions against Mr. Anthony's license privileges.

The above ruling was issued following yesterday's informal hearing.

01-11-15³ **VOIDED CLAIM – FOURTH RACE**
 A claim deposited by trainer Rod Cone for #2 STORM THE CHANNEL was voided by the Stewards after Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin reported the gelding was off in the right front and placed on the Vet's List.

01-11-15⁴ **STEWARDS INQUIRY – EIGHTH RACE – NO CHANGE**
 The Stewards lit the inquiry lamp to review an incident just before the wire involving #3 I WILL FOLLOW (2nd – Marcial Ramirez) and #5 ALPINE GATHERING (3rd – Frank Alvarado).

Following a thorough review the Stewards confirmed the original order of finish. Tapes showed that Ramirez allowed his horse to drift in during the final strides which caused Alvarado to check his mount. The incident did not cost ALPINE GATHERING the opportunity to finish second so no action was warranted with respect to the placings. Ramirez will view the replays with the Stewards on Thursday.
