All three Stewards were present at 11:00 a.m. for a continuation of the Moya hearing which was carried over from May 7, after post time constraints caused the session to conclude before all testimony and evidence was submitted. Also, a companion case for Rodrigo Maldonado was opened and submitted after both attorneys, Mary Cain Simon and Wiley Driskill stipulated to the evidence that would be included before this panel. Both sessions were concluded by 3:30 p.m.

06-04-15² **SECOND RACE – PULLED UP**

#4 LEWKODONIA, trained by Louis San Juan and ridden by Alejandro Gomez, was eased and dismounted at the 3/16 when the jockey felt the horse was in distress. Dr. Sporer diagnosed the mare unsound in the upper left hind at the scene and the horse was removed from the track in the horse ambulance. A later diagnosis at the Receiving Barn by the attending veterinarian stated the horse may have ruptured a

femoral artery and was bleeding internally. LEWKODONIA's condition will be monitored in the coming days.

06-05-15² **STEWARDS INQUIRY - ACCIDENT- SIXTH RACE - NO CHANGE**
 The Stewards hung the inquiry sign after #1 JACK DIZ with Ricardo Gonzalez in the saddle stumbled at the start and unseated the rider. After a thorough review the Stewards affirmed the order of finish on the tote board.

Tapes showed that JACK DIZ broke in a tangle, losing his footing and, in trying to regain his balance JACK DIZ caused Gonzalez to lose his balance. The horse angled to the left and broke through the inner turf rail and into the infield. JACK DIZ galloped behind the field and was finally captured by the outrider.

Jockey Gonzalez escaped injury and was cleared by Dr. Seftel to ride the next race. JACK DIZ suffered some minor lacerations which were addressed with stitches and staples. An accident report is attached.

06-06-15¹ **FILM REVIEW**
 Jockeys Maicol Severino and Ricardo Gonzalez viewed tapes of yesterday's races with the Stewards. Severino was cautioned about applying the whip when a horse was well back and Gonzalez was admonished to be clear before changing lanes in the stretch.

06-06-15² **MARTIN RULING (CASE #15GG0052)**

RULING#89

Trainer **JOHN F. MARTIN**, who started the horse **LOOP CURRENT EDDIE**, winner of the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on April 18, 2015, is fined the sum of Five Hundred Dollars

(\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1877 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: More than one approved medication – Phenylbutazone 0.68 ug/ml & Ketepofen 13.6 ng/ml [class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Martin appeared, waived his right to a formal hearing, and pled guilty. Martin did not have a specific explanation and attributed the double to a miscommunication at the barn.

STEWARDS INQUIRY - ACCIDENT– TENTH RACE – NO CHANGE

The Stewards illuminated the inquiry sign to determine the course of an accident right after the start of this six furlong sprint after #3 REDNECK GIRL ridden by David C. Lopez broke through the inside rail extension from the chute which caused Lopez to become unseated. After a thorough review the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish.

Tapes showed that REDNECK GIRL broke alertly and shortly thereafter bolted inward crashing through the rail extension. Lopez seemed to lose his balance when the filly bolted and fell directly into the path of a trailing horse where it appeared #1 SHEZGETTIN'ERDONE stepped on or kicked the downed rider.

The horse continued going the wrong direction on the track until she reached the gap gate at the 6 ½ and pulled herself up at the outside rail and was captured. Lopez was taken to the hospital where he was diagnosed with hairline fractures in three lower vertebrae. REDNECK GIRL escaped injuries in the incident. An accident report is attached to these minutes.
