Castillo, Jr.**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before August 21, 2015, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), #1489 (h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License and #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation).

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Castillo Jr. failed to appear to address the alleged violation of rules cited above.

The horse laid on the ground for approximately ten minutes before trying to stand and eventually regained her legs enough to stand. While the horse was being attended to by track Veterinarian, Dr. Sporer the horses for the race sent out and the race started after a delay of fifteen minutes. Following the running of the race the horse ambulance was brought back

to the paddock and the horse finally walked into the ambulance about thirty minutes from when she flipped over. By the 3<sup>rd</sup> race the racing program was back on schedule.
