11-19-2015⁴ **OWNER ROGER N. DOWNEY RULING #28 (REFERENCE 11/13/2015²)**

Owner **Roger N. Downey** is hereby suspended thirty (30) days, November 23, 2015 through December 22, 2015 inclusive and fined the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1970 (Wagering On Competing Horse) on September 12, 2015.

The ruling listed above was issued following deliberation on the matter. Regarding the penalty the vote was unanimous however, Steward McHargue was of the opinion there was also a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

11-19-2015⁵ **VOIDED CLAIMS**

Claims were voided on #2 Gem Of A Gal (trainer Steve Sherman) claimant Jonathan Wong, #5 Neversaynever (trainer John Martin) claimant Jerry Hollendorfer in the fourth race and in the fifth race #4 Surprise Sale (trainer Jeff Metz) claimant Gordon Wells. All three claims were voided after the horses were placed on the Veterinarian's List for unsoundness.

11-20-2015³ **TRAINER ADOLFO ORTIZ (CASE 15GG0116) AND OWNER LUIS E. MARISCAL (CASE 15GG0131) MEDICATION HEARINGS (CLENBUTEROL)**

Separate related hearings were held this morning for trainer Adolfo Ortiz and owner Luis Mariscal. Both parties were cited after the horse Snowy Gaddafy tested positive for Clenbuterol following the running of the 3rd race at The San Joaquin County Fair (Stockton) on September 12, 2015.

Present at the Ortiz hearing in addition to the Board of Stewards were Mr. Ortiz, Mr. Mariscal, Attorney Brian Pitnick, California Horse Racing Board Investigator Luis Quezada and California Horse Racing Board Counsel Phil Laird. The same individuals were also present at Mr. Mariscal's hearing with the exception of Mr. Ortiz. After the completion of the hearings the matters were submitted for decision.

This was another case of an owner training a horse up to a race then placing the horse in the trainer's name so the horse could race.

11-20-2015⁴ **JOCKEY RICARDO GONZALEZ ACCIDENT/FIFTH RACE**

Following the running of the fifth race while galloping out #1 Stand And Salute swerved left and unseated Jockey Gonzalez on the 7/8th turn. After examination by track physician Dr. Seftel Mr. Gonzalez was taken off the remainder of his mounts due to a wrist injury.

11-20-2015⁵ **VOIDED CLAIM**

The claim submitted prior to the eighth race for #1 The Great Caper (Trainer, R.B. Hess) by trainer Robertino Diodoro was voided after the horse was placed on the veterinary list for unsoundness.

11-20-2015⁶ **RACE REVIEW 3RD RACE**

Following the running of the third race a Stewards review was conducted on the stretch run involving #3 Hula Girl (2nd place-Jockey Russell Baze) and #1 Bushida (5th race-Jockey Pedro Terrero).

After reviewing all the recorded views the race was made official. The recordings show #3 attempting to go through a narrow opening along the rail inside #1 as number #1 steps inward and constricted the opening. #3 finished in front of #1 so determination of placings was a non-issue.

11-22-2015³ **OWNER LUIS MARISCAL AND ADOLFO ORTIZ/HORSE SNOWY GADDAFY DISQUALIFICATION RULING # 29 (REFERENCE 11/20/2015³)**

Acting on a report from the University of California at Davis Maddy Laboratories, the official Laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that the post race urine sample #F13644 taken from the horse Snowy Gaddafi, winner of the third race at The San Joaquin County Fair (Stockton) on September 12, 2015 contained the prohibited

substance Clenbuterol (Class 3), it is hereby ordered that Snowy Gaddafy be disqualified from all purse monies earned and deemed unplaced in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$4,450.00) earned or awarded to owner Cuadra Mariscal (Luis Mariscal) and trainer Adolfo Ortiz and jockey Irving Orozco be returned to Paymaster of Purses on or before December 26, 2015 for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The above ruling was issued after the board reviewed the evidence submitted at the hearing regarding the positive test.

11-22-2015⁴ **TRAINER STEVEN J. HOWARD RULING #30**

Trainer **Steven J. Howard** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)* for failure to follow track policy regarding toe grabs on the turf course on November 21, 2015; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Howard phoned the Stewards and waived his right to a hearing
