11-27-2015³ **KYLE FREY RULING #31**

Jockey **Kyle Frey** who rode **Southern Loyalty** in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, November 26, 2015, is hereby fined Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Frey and the Stewards reviewed the video of the fifth race from November 26, 2015. Mr. Frey acknowledged using his crop more than three times without giving his mount (#6 Southern Loyalty) the opportunity to respond.

11-27-2015⁴ **KENNETH J. NOLAN-(CASE 15SW0053) (REFER 10-23-15)**

The formal hearing for Kenneth J. Nolan regarding a physical altercation that opened on October 23, 2015 was concluded today. Testimony from Miranda Gramlich, Lance Grenamyler, and Winners Foundation Representative Nora Lee was entered into the record. Closing statements from Mr. Nolan and California Horse Racing Board Investigator Louis Quesada were heard and the record was closed. Decision forthcoming.

11-27-2015⁵ **LATE DECLARATION-5TH RACE**

State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM contacted the Stewards regarding the horse Line Of Doom (Trainer John Brocklebank) scheduled to run in the fifth race. Dr. Franklin reported the two year old gelding was sick and recommended a declaration. The declaration reduced the field to four wagering interests and in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1954 the show pool was cancelled and refunds were ordered.

11-27-2015⁶ **INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION-3RD RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the third race to review an incident near the 3/16 pole involving #3 Nana Wendy (Frank Alvarado) fifth, #5 Port Elizabeth (Kyle Frey) third and #6 Looking For Info (Alejandro Gomez) second.

The video shows #5 Port Elizabeth, on the inside of the three horse spread move out, bump and impede #3 Nana Wendy, who was then forced into #6 Looking For Info, preventing both of those horses the opportunity of a better placing.

After interviewing the riders involved the Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #5 Port Elizabeth from third to fifth.

11-28-2015³**KEN J. NOLAN RULING #32-(CASE # 15SW0053)****#32**

A formal hearing having been held, Trainer **Ken J. Nolan** is hereby suspended ninety (90) days retroactive from September 12, 2015 through December 10, 2015 and placed on probation for the term of his license (10-31-17) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (g)) (Grounds For Denial or Refusal of License) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) on September 12, 2015. As a condition of probation Mr. Nolan must sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. Further San Joaquin County Fair ruling #2, dated September 12, 2015 summarily suspending Mr. Nolan is hereby set aside.

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Ken J. Nolan** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued following the formal hearing that concluded yesterday (11-27-15). This Board of Stewards found Mr. Nolan guilty of initiating a serious altercation that took place in the barn area at the San Joaquin County Fair on September 12, 2015.

11-28-2015⁴**R. B. HESS, SENIOR-RULING # 33****#33**

Trainer **R. B. Hess, Sr.** is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for working the horse **Miss Forty Niner** on November 27, 2015 while the horse was still on the veterinarian's list; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866 (b) (1) (Veterinarian's List).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Hess met with the Stewards regarding the filly Miss Forty Niner. The three year old filly was a veterinarian declaration (sick) on November 27, 2015 and had a recorded workout on November 28, 2015, in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866 (b) (1) Veterinarian List.

Mr. Hess indicated the filly had a temperature on Tuesday, November 24, 2015 and he didn't realize he would be in violation of the rule as he submitted the scratch card on November 25, 2015.

11-28-2015⁵**JOSEPH BROOK-RULING #34****#34**

Trainer **Joseph Brook** is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* for failure to follow proper procedure regarding the policy for running the horse **Kuuipo** unshod in the second race on Friday November 27, 2015; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (b) (Examination Required).

Mr. Brook met with the Stewards regarding his failure to follow the prescribed procedure for running a horse unshod. He was reminded that a notation on the entry must be made every time the horse runs.

Jockey **Kyle Frey** who rode **Port Elizabeth** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, November 27, 2015 is hereby suspended three (3) racing days (December 5, 6 and 10, 2015) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification on his mount from third to fifth a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Frey and the Stewards reviewed the video of the third race from November 27, 2015. Mr. Frey acknowledged that he erred and accepted the penalty imposed.

11-28-2015⁷ **INQUIRY-NO CHANGE-6TH RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the sixth race to review an incident near the 5/16 pole involving #3 Code Warrior (Anne Sanguinetti) First and #6 Cousin Claire (Frank Alvarado) second.

After interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously not to change the order of finish.

The video shows #3 Code Warrior stepping out from behind the leaders near the 5/16 pole and bumps #6 Cousin Claire.

The Stewards concluded there was interference; however, the incident did not alter the outcome.

11-28-2015⁸ **CLAIM VOIDED-9TH RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer Candi Tollett for the filly Bella Caterina (Trainer Ricardo Perez) after the state veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM, reported the four year old filly was unsound. Bella Caterina was returned to the Ricardo Perez barn.

11-28-2015³ **RULING #36-IRVING OROZCO**

Jockey **Irving Orozco** is hereby summarily suspended pending an appearance at a hearing before this Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report) #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct).

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Irving Orozco** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued following a series of events involving Mr. Orozco's behavior.

On Thursday, November 26, 2015, Mr. Orozco was late reporting to the jockey's quarters, missed his first two mounts and was advised to meet with the Stewards on November 27, 2015. On Friday, November 27, 2015, Mr. Orozco not only failed to meet with the Stewards as directed, but he was late reporting to the jockey's quarters and once again was ordered to meet with the Stewards on November 28, 2015.

On Saturday, November 28, 2015, Mr. Orozco having failed to meet with the Stewards once again arrived late to the jockey's quarters. Mr. Orozco was then directed to submit to a field test (urine) administered by the California Horse Racing Board investigative staff.

California Horse Racing Board investigator Louis Quezada advised the Stewards that the field urine sample submitted by Mr. Orozco tested positive for Amphetamine and Marijuana and we removed him from his mounts. He was again ordered to appear in the Steward's office today. Mr. Orozco failed to appear today and resulted in this ruling.

11-29-2015⁴ **HORSE GOES WRONG-3RD RACE**

The three year old gelding Bounty On The Run (Trainer A. L. Diaz) went wrong near the 5/16 pole and was pulled up by jockey Silvio Amador. Track Veterinarian Sarah Sporer, DVM, reported the three year old gelding fractured his left front ankle and was euthanized on the track.

11-29-2015⁵ **CLAIM VOIDED-5TH RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by Jerry Hollendorfer for the four year old gelding Sir Vronski, (Trainer Quinn Howey) after the state veterinarian, Forest Franklin DVM, reported the gelding was unsound in the left foreleg and will be placed on the veterinarian's list. Sir Vronski was returned to the Quinn Howey barn.
