#### **ENTRIES AND SCRATCHES**

Steward Will Meyers was on hand to handle scratches, transfers and entry duty. Minor changes were taken for Thursday. Nine races were drawn for Saturday's card including four turf races.

#### **THURSDAY**

04-21-2016<sup>1</sup>

#### **PROGRAM ERROR**

In the 7<sup>th</sup> race #9 Kohala was entered in a turf race which was a surface change for the horse. Trainer Dan Franko asked the Racing Office staff, in particular Carrie Fawcett, if he needed to declare "shoes on" since it was a surface change. Ms. Fawcett incorrectly informed Mr. Franko he did not need to note the change. Ms. Fawcett and Director of Racing/Racing Secretary Patrick Mackey were in to discuss the issue. As a result of the discussion, the horse will be allowed to run with announcements being made and the following ruling was issued:

Racing Secretary **Patrick A. Mackey** is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)\* for the failure of the Racing Office to follow proper procedures when declaring that the horse Kohala will race shod in the seventh race on Thursday, April 21, 2016; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1853 (Examination Required).

04-21-2016<sup>3</sup> **3<sup>RD</sup> RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

#8 Family Forever (Trainer Sergio Ledezma) broke outward at the start causing apprentice Jockey Cerapio Figueroa to lose his left stirrup momentarily. The action caused #8 to lag significantly behind the field at the start and replays were given to show #8 caused its own problem and no inquiry was needed.

**FRIDAY**04-22-2016<sup>1</sup> **CRISPIN RULING****#86**

Jockey **Joe Crispin** who rode **Tropical Heat** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, April 17, 2016 is fined the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense).

The above ruling was issued after Crispin appeared and stated he was really trying to comply with the rule but it was hard for an "old dog to learn new tricks". Mr. Crispin is one of the few riders who still occasionally forget the crop rule.

04-22-2016<sup>2</sup> **MEDINA HEARING CASE # 16GG0019**

Jockey Luis Medina is charged with violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1530 (Cases Not Covered) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Racing) concerning questionable possession of a fellow rider's riding crop.

Attorney Alex Verbec appeared to represent Mr. Medina. Mr. Verbec informed this Board that Mr. Medina missed his flight and would not appear. The next available date for hearing is May 13, 2016 which was agreed upon by California Horse Racing Board counsel Phil Laird, Investigator Louis Quesada, Attorney Verbec and the Stewards. Mr. Verbec understood and agreed that since Mr. Medina had already been given two continuances that he would be suspended for failure to appear. Mr. Verbec stated that his case was based on Mr. Medina's personal testimony and wished not to proceed further today.

 The 6<sup>th</sup> race was reduced to four wagering interests with the two aforementioned scratches and show wagering was cancelled in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1954 (Pari-mutuel Pools).

04-22-2016<sup>6</sup> **7<sup>TH</sup> RACE INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION**  
 The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in deep stretch involving first place finisher #2 High Greeley (Juan Sanchez) and 5<sup>th</sup> place finisher #1 Glitter Of Silver (Abel Cedillo). Tapes show #2 drift out into the path of #1 causing Jockey Cedillo to check his mount to avoid heels. #7 "Who Dee Knee" catches and passes #1 for 4<sup>th</sup> place when Jockey Cedillo has to check. In the unanimous opinion of the Stewards #1 was cost a chance at a better placing. #2 was disqualified from first to fifth for the infraction. Jockey Juan Sanchez will appear before this Board tomorrow.

 A claim deposited by trainer William Delia for #5 "Tiz Fitting" was voided by the Stewards after Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin placed the horse on the Vet's List following the race. "Tiz Fitting" was returned to the barn of Jose Bautista.

04-23-2016<sup>1</sup> **MEDINA RULING – CASE 16GG0019 (REF 04/22/2016<sup>2</sup>)**

Jockey **Luis A. Medina**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before April 22, 2016, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Luis. A. Medina** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Medina was contacted this morning and informed of our decision and the new hearing date of May 13, 2016. A copy was faxed to the Stewards at Emerald Downs where Medina is currently riding and also to Medina's attorney Alex Verbec.

04-23-2016<sup>2</sup> **JUAN SANCHEZ RULING (REF 04/22/2016)**

**#89**

Jockey **Juan Sanchez** who rode **High Greeley** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, April 22, 2016 is suspended three (3) racing days (April 30, May 1, and May 5, 2016) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to fifth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Carless Riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California

Jockey Sanchez reviewed films of yesterday's 7<sup>th</sup> race in which his mount was disqualified from first to fifth. Sanchez agreed with our assertion that he let his mount drift out in deep stretch causing interference. Since we couldn't blame the horse the above ruling was issued.
