10-21-2016²**SAFETY VEST UPDATE**

Stewards throughout the state have received notice that rule #1689.1 (Safety Vest Required) is being amended to read that ANY person mounted on a horse on the track of an association must wear a safety vest. The change is effective immediately but warnings will be issued until November 15, 2016 of this year.

Notices were placed on the overnights and posted in the barn area. Morning and afternoon outriders both here and at Pleasanton, were informed of the change to alert all participants not already in compliance.

10-21-2016³**MEDINA RULING****#1**

Jockey **Luis Medina** who was scheduled to ride **Charlie My Love** in the third race on Thursday, October 20, 2016 is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* for failure to appear to ride the horse; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after Medina was contacted by telephone and after he admitted he gave the trainer a call. Medina later changed his mind but unfortunately it was after scratch time, hence the fine.

10-21-2016⁴**CLAIM VOIDED-SECOND RACE**

A claim deposited by trainer Sheldon Paldanius for Anya Amasova was declared void after Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin examined the mare and diagnosed her as lame in the right front. She was placed on the Veterinarian's List and returned to the barn of William Delia.

10-21-2016⁵**STEWARDS INQUIRY-THIRD RACE-NO CHANGE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review close quarters near the 1/8 and the reason #4 Implicated (4th, Catalino Martinez) steadied his mount. After a thorough investigation the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish. Tapes showed that #2 Wedding Blush (1st, Abel Cedillo) stepped out while marginally clear of Implicated which caused Implicated to alter course and resulted in the close quarters with horses to Martinez' outside. Martinez was forced to steady his mount to correct the situation. The

Stewards did not feel the incident warranted a disqualification but Cedillo will view the tapes of the race with the Stewards in the morning.

10-22-2016²**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Abel Cedillo reviewed the tapes of yesterday's third race in which his mount was the subject of a Steward's inquiry. Abel moved his mount out from behind the leader at the 1/8 in search of racing room and in doing so took a rival off his path and caused that horse to steady. Although Cedillo's actions did not cost the other horse the opportunity at a better placing he did, none the less, cause interference. The following ruling was issued:

Jockey **Abel Cedillo** who rode **Wedding Blush** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, October 21, 2016 is suspended five (5) racing days (October 29, 30 and November 3, 4 and 5, 2016 for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding-second offense in sixty days).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

10-22-2016³**FREY HEARING**

An informal hearing was held for Valet Jay Frey after he failed to saddle a horse assigned to him in the first race yesterday. Jay offered a variety of excuses for the incident none of which would relieve him of his responsibility to take care of his duties. The following ruling was issued:

Valet **Jay G. Frey** is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to properly perform his duties as a valet for the first race on Friday, October 21, 2016.

10-22-2016⁴**SYSTEM GLITCHES**

Shortly after the field crossed the finish line for the first race the in-house phone system went down and communication was brought to a temporary halt. Thanks to the world of cell phones a work-around was quickly put in place. The outage was short-lived and the phones were up and running shortly thereafter.

The main track ambulance was taken out of service prior to the first race today after transmission problems took traveling in reverse out of the equation. The back-up ambulance was pressed into service and though it experienced battery/alternator issues during the afternoon it completed its mission. The prognosis for tomorrow is that one or the other will be available for use.
