12-26-2016<sup>3</sup>**RULING #1-ALEJANDRO GOMEZ (refer 12-11-2016<sup>8</sup>)**

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Gomez and the Stewards reviewed the video of the second race from December 11, 2016. Mr. Gomez acknowledged he erred and accepted the penalty imposed.

Jockey **Alejandro Gomez** who rode **Buy Me A Drink** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, December 11, 2016 is hereby suspended three (3) racing days January 2, 6 and 7, 2017 for altering course without sufficient clearance around the far turn and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California

12-26-2016<sup>4</sup>**INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION-7<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the seventh race to review an incident going into the first turn of this one mile turf event.

The video shows #4 Urban Bourbon (Julien Couton) fifth, while in tight quarters along the rail, failed to negotiate the turn properly. The hard to control three year old bore out near the 7/8 pole bumped and severely impeded #8 Call Saul (Kyle Frey) who finished last.

After interviewing the riders involved and the Patrol Judges, the Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #4 Urban Bourbon from fifth to last.

12-26-2016<sup>5</sup>**INQUIRY-ACCIDENT-9<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the ninth race to examine an accident near the ¼ pole. #5 Act Your Wage (Francisco Duran) clipped the heels of #8 Global Event (Abel Cedillo) stumbled and unseated jockey Duran.

After a thorough review of all video angles, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows #5 Act Your Wage along the rail trailing #8 Global Event (Abel Cedillo) with #6 Hunter's Angel (Brandon Boulanger) sixth outside the latter.

The Stewards determined the video angles were inconclusive as to who was at fault, Global Event or Hunter's Angel, for the hole closing. Both Cedillo and Boulanger will meet with the Stewards tomorrow.

Jockey Duran was uninjured, as was his mount Act Your Wage.

12-29-2016<sup>3</sup>**VIDEO REVIEW**

Jockey Julien Couton and the Stewards reviewed the video of the seventh race from December 26, 2016. Mr. Couton's mount, Urban Bourbon (Trainer Blaine Wright) was disqualified for interference during that one mile turf event.

Following the review, the Stewards unanimously agreed that Mr. Couton did all he could to prevent the interference and not was penalized.

12-29-2016<sup>4</sup>**VIDEO REVIEW**

The Stewards met separately with jockeys Abell Cedilla and Brandon Boulanger for a review of the video of the ninth race from December 26, 2016.

Both riders blamed the other for closing an opening along the rail near the ¼ pole that resulted in jockey Francisco Duran's mount, Act Your Wage, to clip the heels of Cedillo's mount and throw Duran to the turf.

The Stewards agreed unanimously that the video could not conclusively put the blame on either Cedillo or Boulanger; however, as the latter was on the outside of the former, he was most likely the culprit.

Mr. Boulanger was advised that if the video supported what we believe to be the case, a stiff penalty would be imposed. A stern warning to the young rider was issued.

12-29-2016<sup>5</sup>**CLAIM VOIDED-2<sup>ND</sup> RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer Ed Moger for the six year old gelding American Aristocat (Trainer Tim McCanna), the winner of the second race.

State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM, reported American Aristocat was lame in the left foreleg. The gelding was returned to the McCanna barn.

12-29-2016<sup>6</sup>**INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION-4<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fourth race for a review of an incident inside the 1/16 pole involving #5 Charlie My Love (Hugo Herrera) fourth and #9 Belle's Command (Julien Couton) who finished sixth.

After interviewing the Patrol Judges, the riders involved and reviewing the video, the

stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #5 Charlie My Love from fourth and place her sixth.

The video shows Charlie My Love drifts in and impedes #9 Belle's Command, preventing the later the opportunity of a better placing.

The veteran rider was a late replacement and he explained he thought his license expired December 31, 2016, the same as his Mexico license. Mr. Amador renewed his license this morning.

Mr. Amador, while explaining his license issue as previously noted, apologized for

forgetting the crop rule and acknowledged he struck his mount more than three times without allowing the horse to respond.

12-30-2016<sup>5</sup> **RULING #4-HUGO HERRERA**

**#4**

Jockey **Hugo Herrera** who rode **Charlie My Love** in the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, December 29, 2016 is hereby suspended five (5) racing days (January 6, 7, 8, 12 & 13, 2017) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to sixth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Herrera and the Stewards reviewed the video of the fourth race from December 29, 2016

Mr. Herrera readily admitted he erred in allowing his mount to drift in and impede a rival resulting in the disqualification of his mount. This is Mr. Herrera's second careless riding offense within sixty days, justifying the five day suspension.
