FILM REVIEW

Jockeys Joe Crispin and Frank Alvarado reviewed tapes of last Monday's races with the Stewards with attention paid to their use of the crop. After seeing the tapes both admitted that they exceeded the allowable limit and the following rulings were issued:

Jockey **Joe Crispin** who rode **Peppered Pro** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Monday, January 2, 2017 is hereby fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-third offense in sixty days).

Jockey **Frank Alvarado** who rode **Motoring Around** in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on Monday, January 2, 2017 is hereby fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense in sixty days).

01-06-2017³ **FINANCIAL RESOLVED (CASE #16GG0148)**

A financial complaint filed by San Francisco Equine against owner Michael Timchenko was settled prior to a hearing when Dr.Kuhlmann informed the Stewards that Timchenko satisfied the outstanding obligation with a payment of \$259.09.

01-06-2017⁴ **CLAIM VOIDED-SEVENTH RACE**

A claim deposited by trainer John F. Martin for the horse Pop Fizz Clink was declared void after Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin deemed the horse lame and placed her on the Veterinarian's List. Pop Fizz Clink was returned to the barn of Bill McLean.

01-07-2017¹ **WISSAR RULING (CASE #16GG0149)**

Gloria G. Wissar, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before January 6, 2017, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Gloria G. Wissar** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued when Ms. Wissar failed to appear at a hearing into a complaint filed by San Francisco Equine alleging \$4,682.18 due for unpaid veterinary services.

01-07-2017² **SHERMAN RULING**

Trainer **Steve M. Sherman** who was scheduled to start the horse **Oil** is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty For Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866 (e) (Veterinarian's List-failed post work-out blood test) necessitating a late declaration in the fourth race on Saturday, January 7, 2017.

The above ruling was published after Sherman appeared for an informal hearing and accepted responsibility for a post workout blood sample that failed to meet the criteria necessary to remove his horse from the Veterinarian's List thus necessitating a late scratch.

01-07-2017³ **FINANCIAL SETTLED (CASE #16GG0151)**

A financial complaint filed by San Francisco Equine against owner Dawn Crump which was scheduled for a hearing this morning was resolved prior the hearing when she signed a payment agreement with Dr. Allison for payment of \$50.00 per month until the balance of \$571.14 is paid in full.

01-07-2017⁴ **CLAIM VOIDED-FIFTH RACE**

A claim deposited by Jonathan Wong for the horse Inner City was declared void by the Stewards after Dr. Franklin reported the horse was lame in the left front and placed him on the Veterinarian's List. Trainer bill McLean retained possession of the horse.

01-07-2017⁵ **STEWARDS INQUIRY-ACCIDENT-EIGHTH RACE-NO CHANGE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to determine the cause of an accident at the 1/16 involving #4 Tough Fame, trained by Valerie Rhoden and ridden by Juan Hernandez, after the horse fell and dislodged Hernandez. Tapes show the horse went wrong while racing toward the rear of the field and no other horses were involved. Hernandez suffered a broken collarbone and Tough Fame was euthanized at the scene.

01-08-2017² **LORRAINE RULING (CASE# 16GG0150)****#15**

Jason Lorraine (DBA Corsair Holdings) having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before January 7, 2017, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Jason Lorraine (DBA Corsair Holdings)** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued when Lorraine did not appear at the appointed time and place for a hearing into a complaint filed by San Francisco Equine. The complaint alleges \$5,742.89 due for veterinary services rendered.

01-08-2017³ **TRACK CONDITION CONCERNS**

Following the running of today's third race some members of the jockey colony expressed reservations over the condition of the Tapeta all weather surface. It appeared that water was not draining properly in the area near the finish line. A week long storm was the cause of the problem.

Those concerns were passed along to management and the track crew who made concerted efforts to correct the problem. A pump was brought in to clear the infield drainage ditch which helped to alleviate the problem.

The riders took a vote to determine whether they would continue to ride their mounts. Four jockeys took off citing safety concerns and the rest of the colony persevered. The events caused a half hour delay in the fourth race post time and the balance of the card was completed without a noteworthy incident.

01-08-2017⁴ **CLAIM VOIDED-EIGHTH RACE**

#2 Don't Keep Time was returned to the care of trainer Sam Dilaura after a claim deposited by Victor Trujillo was declared void when Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin place the horse on the Veterinarian's List as unsound.
