### WAITE RULING

#### #22

Outrider **Michael J. Waite** is hereby fined the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)\* for failure to follow Golden Gate Fields' policy regarding cell phone use during morning workout hours; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting) and #1870 (Conditions of a Race Meeting Binding upon Licensees).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Waite appeared in the Stewards' office after he has recently received numerous warnings for cell phone use while on duty. He stated that he will leave the cell phone in his car from now on.

### VILLAMAR RULING

#### #23

Trainer **CANDELARIO VILLAMAR** is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for failure to have the horse **SOUTHEAST ASIA** on the grounds of the association twenty-four (24) hours prior to the race necessitating a late scratch in the sixth race on Friday, January 20, 2017; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1588 (k) (Horse Ineligible to Start in a Race).

The above ruling was issued after Villamar failed to have his horse on the grounds 24 hours prior to post time in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1588 (Horse ineligible to Start in a Race).

**OROZCO RULING**

**#24**

Jockey **Irving Orozco** who rode **Become An Insider** in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on Monday, January 16, 2017 is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense in the last sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after Orozco appeared and agreed that he used the crop four times in a row down the stretch.

**3RD RACE INQUIRY/OBJECTION-DISQUALIFICATION**

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in the stretch involving #5 Fast Pass (Abel Cedillo, 1<sup>st</sup>) and #3 Infamous Style (Joe Crispin, 4<sup>th</sup>). Jockey Joe Crispin aboard #3 also lodged a claim of foul against #5 for alleged interference.

After review and talking to the riders involved #5 was disqualified from 1<sup>st</sup> and placed 4<sup>th</sup> in a unanimous decision.

Video replays show #5 is steered into the path of #3 causing jockey Crispin to check #3 sharply near the 1/8 pole to avoid heels. #3 comes on strongly to be fourth beaten a neck for third.

**CEDILLO RULING**

**#25**

Jockey **Abel Cedillo** who rode **Fast Pass** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, January 20, 2017 is suspended five (5) racing days (January 28, 29, and February 2, 3 and 4, 2017) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to fourth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding-second offense in the last 60 days).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Cedillo appeared, reviewed video replays, and readily admitted to his error in judgement. He felt that he should have taken his horse inside of horses instead of pointing to the outside which caused the interference.

Jockey **Julien Couton** is fined the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to report to the film review when notified to do so.

The above ruling was issued after Couton appeared and apologized for forgetting to come in yesterday.

Couton reviewed the fourth race from last Monday along with jockey Ricky Gonzalez. Couton was not issued a penalty as it was determined that his mount was not the sole contributor to the tight quarters in deep stretch.
