**RULING #27-JEANETTE LARSON (CASE #16GG0082)**  
**RULING #28-MICHAEL LARSON (CASE #16GG0083)**

**#27**

Acting on an Order of Remand following the adoption of a stipulated agreement by the California Horse Racing Board, Owner **Jeanette Larson** is suspended sixty (60) days, January 30, 2017 through March 30, 2017 for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1840 (Veterinarian Practices and Treatments Restricted), #1843 (b), (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances), #1844 (a) (Authorized Medication), #1890 (a) (Possession of Contraband-hypodermic needle and syringe/injectable Flunixin) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Jeannette Larson** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**#28**

Acting on an Order of Remand following the adoption of a stipulated agreement by the California Horse Racing Board, Trainer **Michael Larson** who trained the horse "**Shoshoneforever**" on or about July 1, 2016 is suspended thirty (30) days, January 30, 2017 through February 28, 2017 for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), #1843 (b) (c) (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844 (a) (Authorized Medication).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Michael Larson** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above rulings were issued upon receipt of an order of remand from the California Horse Racing Board outlining the terms of the stipulated agreements between Mr. & Mrs. Larson and the California Horse Racing Board.

Jeanette Larson was observed injecting the horse Shoshoneforever with Flunixin (Banamine) on July 1, 2016, in the Larson barn at the Alameda County Fairgrounds. Shoshoneforever was entered to race on July 3, 2016 at Golden Gate Fields.

**CLAIM VOIDED-5<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer John Martin for Heroes For Ghosts (trainer James Kasparoff) after State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin reported the five year old gelding was lame in the left hind leg. Heroes For Ghosts was returned to the Kasparoff barn.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Wong waived his right to a hearing and admitted he erred when he worked his horse, Liana Skye, within seventy-two hours of the horse being scratched for being sick.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Ms. Peric met with the Stewards and stated she was running late and forgot to put her safety vest on before entering the track.

Pony person **ASHLEY N. PERIC** is fined the sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)\* for failure to wear a safety vest while mounted on a horse on the track on January 27, 2017; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1689.1 (Safety Vest Required).

01-28-2017<sup>5</sup> **FORMAL HEARING**

The Stewards conducted a formal hearing to address complaints filed against trainer Faith Taylor, trainer Albert "Mike" Lenzini, owner Robert Jones and owner Gary Marrone.

Ms. Taylor's attorney, James Ghidella and Safety Steward Richard Lewis were also present. Court Reporter Representative Christine Niccolli, recorded the proceedings. All respondents consented to a single hearing, as the accusations against each are related to the same situation.

Investigator Joe Mulligan presented the cases for the California Horse Racing Board.

According to the complaint, Safety Steward Richard Lewis observed the horse "Power Of Thirteen" stabled in trainer Faith Taylor's barn on January 7, 2017, after "Power Of

Thirteen had been claimed from Robert Jones and Lloyd Mason (Trainer Tylor) by trainer Michael Lenzini as an authorized agent for owner Gary Marrone on December 29, 2016.

Following the submission of documents and the testimony of those present, were entered into the record, the hearing was brought to a close.

Jockey **Silvio Amador** who rode **Jackotree** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, January 28, 2017 is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-third offense in sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Amador and the Stewards reviewed the video of the third race from January 28, 2017. Mr. Amador acknowledged he violated the crop rule and accepted the penalty imposed.

01-29-2017<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY-NO CHANGE-9<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the ninth race to review an incident in the stretch involving #6 Parkers Delight (William Antongeorgi) fourth and #9 Pretty Emma (Irving Orozco) who finished eighth.

After considering the opinions of the riders involved, the patrol Judge and reviewing all video angles, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows #9 Pretty Emma steady while considering to move through an opening along the rail inside #6 Parkers Delight near the 1/16 pole. The opening was there, but Pretty Emma was reluctant and then jockey Orozco thought better of making the move.

The Stewards voided the claim submitted by trainer Andy Mathis for #9 Pretty Emma (Trainer Monty Meier) after State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin DVM, reported the five year old mare was unsound in the right foreleg. Pretty Emma was returned to the Monty Meir barn.
