03-24-2017<sup>1</sup> **HOSKINS/AGUILAR HEARING CONTINUED (REFERENCE 03/02/2017<sup>3</sup>)**  
 Testimony continued today with Pleasanton Stable Superintendent Kevin Ingram, groom Dimitrio “Mono” Gomez, Safety Steward Richard Lewis, owner/Stable Foremen Cynthia Hoskins and trainer Jacob Aguilar all testifying. There was no testimony that the four horses in question were malnourished or mistreated. The only solid testimony was that the horses had no bedding on the day in question, but the stalls were clean. Groom Gomez had been working on an as needed basis for Aguilar since March when Hoskins had Rotator Cuff surgery and Aguilar had his main string at Golden Gate Fields. Ms. Hoskins testified that she was away from the barn on Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup> until the day in question Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup> and thought groom Gomez had enough supplies for the horses. She was upset the horses were not bedded on straw but was adamant that they had food and water. Disposition to follow.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Haynes failed to respond to a complaint alleging two past due bills of \$444.00 and \$1,048.00 to San Francisco Equine, Inc.

Trainer **Jacob G. Aguilar** is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)\* for failure to keep his employee work list up to date on July 12, 2016: a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1895 (Trainer to Insure Licensed Participation).

The above ruling was issued following deliberation over testimony and evidence presented in this two day hearing. The allegations of mistreatment and improperly labelled medications were deemed unfounded. Groom Dimitrio Gomez had been working for Aguilar since March and not put on Aguilar's work list in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1895 (Trainer's Duty to Insure Licensed Participation).
