ENTRIES FOR SATURDAY

Steward John Herbuveaux was on duty to handle owner & trainer transfers, finish the minutes for the week and oversee Saturday's entries.

CLEAR MORNING

This morning's duties consisted of paperwork catchup and routine racing office queries.

11-30-2017²

1ST RACE-STEWARDS REVIEW

The Stewards reviewed the start of the 1st race for the benefit of the public. Shortly after the start #6 Dizzy Dancer stumbled and jockey Pedro Terrero lost his inside stirrup and lost 10 lengths to the field as he attempted to regather it. He was successful after an 1/8 of a mile and managed to get back in contention and finished 5th. Since no other horses were involved and a fair start was received, no inquiry was needed.

11-30-2017³

2ND RACE JOCKEY OBJECTION-NO CHANGE

Jockey Pedro Flores aboard #3 La Classic Gold, who finished 5th, lodged a claim of foul against 3rd place finisher #8 Miss Diamond G and jockey Frank Alvarado for alleged interference near the 3/16 pole. After talking to the riders and reviewing the video, no change was the unanimous decision. While #8 does come in toward the rail tightening up the space between her and the #3, there was always room for #3 and no interference was detected.

11-30-2017⁴**INQUIRY-7TH RACE-DISQUALIFICATION-MAJORITY DECISION**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the stretch drive of the 7th race, mainly concerning the actions of #5 Pampled who finished 5th with Cristobal Herrera aboard. After review and talking to the riders #5 was placed 6th in a majority vote for interference to #2 Hedoesitinstyle (Catalino Martinez). Steward Nevin felt the #5 should have been placed last.

Video shows that #5 is behind a wall of horses as the field enters the stretch. #'s #1 Pepper Sings (Rocco Bowen), #3 Soolaimon (Frank Alvarado) and #2 Hedoesitinstyle form the wall. #5 has nowhere to go and bulls his way between #1 & #3 causing those two and #2 on the inside to check. #3 was hardly affected and #1 was fading quickly at the time. #2 was beaten a nose by #5 for 5th and the majority felt #2 could have attained 5th position without interference.

Jockey Pedro Flores watched the video of Thursday's 2nd race in which he had claimed foul. Review and discussion convinced him that the incident was not worthy of an objection.

12-01-2017³**ANTONGEORGI FILM REVIEW**

Video of the previous day's 2nd race was reviewed to look at actions in deep stretch. This panel complimented Jockey Antongeorgi on his effort to keep his mount straight but warned him of making it too tight for others.

12-01-2017⁴**HERRERA RULING #32****#32**

Jockey **CRISTOBAL HERRERA** who rode **FAIR ADVANTAGE** in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, November 30, 2017 is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense in the past sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after jockey Cristobal Herrera appeared and admitted to misuse, too many strikes, of riding crop in the 6th race.

12-01-2017⁵**HERRERA RULING #33 (REFERENCE 11/30/2017⁴)****#33**

Jockey **CRISTOBAL HERRERA** who rode **PAMPLED** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, November 30, 2017 is suspended five (5) racing days December 8, 9, 10, 26 & 29, 2017 for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the

disqualification of his mount from fifth to sixth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding-second offense in the last sixty days).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races within California.

Jockey Cristobal Herrera appeared to review Thursday's 7th race. Films indicated that poor judgement and lack of patience resulted in the disqualification of his mount from 5th to 6th. The above ruling was therefore issued.

12-01-2017⁶ **JOE CRISPIN HEARING**

A formal hearing against jockey Joe Crispin, case #17GG0145, took place today. Present, along with this Board of Stewards, were California Horse Racing Board Investigator Joe Mulligan, Jose Crispin and Court Reporter Christine Niccoli. Decision forthcoming.

CRISPIN RULING #35 (REFERENCE 12/01/2017⁶)

The following ruling was issued after deliberations resulting from the prior day's hearing. Mr. Crispin was spoken with upon publication.

Jockey **JOE A. CRISPIN** having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before November 9, 2017, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1500.1 (a) (Random Drug Testing) and #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers).

During the term of this suspension all licenses and license privileges of **JOE A. CRISPIN** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

12-02-2017⁴ **VOIDED CLAIM**

The claim of #6 Whyyougottabesomean by trainer Val Rhoden was voided after the mare was put on the Veterinarian's List for soundness issues. Horse was returned to the barn of Jerry Hollendorfer.
