RULING #11-EFFRAIN J. MIRANDA

#11

Assistant Starter **EFRAIN J. MIRANDA** is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* for inappropriate actions in the starting gate prior to the start of the third race on Monday, January 1, 2018; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1693 (Control of Horses and Jockeys on Entering the Track).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Miranda, along with Starter Todd Stephens, met with the Stewards for an informal hearing. At issue was Mr. Miranda's actions in the starting gate prior to the start of the third race on Monday, January 1, 2018. Mr. Miranda was observed kicking the horse he was

holding on top of the rump. His explanation was he was trying to make the horse move off the back stall doors.

The veteran assistant was advised that his method was not acceptable and starter Stephens concurred.

01-05-2018⁴**TRAINER JERRY HOLLENDORFER (CASE #17GG0152)**

The Stewards held an informal telephone hearing for trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. Mr. Hollendorfer's horse Lovenseek, the winner of the eighth race on October 21, 2017, showed presence of Dexamethasone (200pg/ml) in the postrace blood sample (GG29492).

Mr. Hollendorfer's assistant trainer, Juan Arriaga was present, as was California Horse Racing Board Investigator Joe Mulligan, who presented the case.

Assistant Trainer Arriaga stated "Lovenseek" had been cut by the crop during a work five days prior to the race in question and was prescribed Naquasone by licensed veterinarian Kim Kuhlman, DVM. Mr. Arriaga went on to say he thought the veterinarian treated "Lovenseek", when he only prescribed and dispensed Naquasone packets to be administered over a four day period, which would explain the Dexamethasone in excess of the permitted level. Dexamethasone is an ingredient in the Naquasone packets.

Decision is forthcoming.....

Jockey **FRANK ALVARADO** who rode **BELLE DE FRANCE** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, January 5, 2018 is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three consecutive times without giving the horse a chance to respond).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Alvarado acknowledged he struck his mount four consecutive times with the riding crop.

01-06-2018⁴**RULING #13-WILLIAM SADOO****#13**

Jockey agent **WILLIAM SADOO** is fined the sum for One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to conduct his business in a proper manner necessitating a late jockey change on Friday, January 5, 2018.

This ruling was issued following discussions with owner Vic Stauffer and jockey agent William Sadoo. Mr. Sadoo stated he did accept calls for his rider, Ignacio Puglisi, on races at Santa Anita and Golden Gate Fields for Friday, January 5, 2018. Mr. Puglisi elected to ride at the former.

Owner/Trainer **JERRY HOLLENDORFER**, who started the horse **LOVENSEEK**, winner of the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields, on October 21, 2017, is fined the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2,500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, drugs and Other Substances-Dexamethasone, in excess of permitted level, 200 pg/ml [class 4]-second violation in 365 days).

The foregoing ruling was issued following the hearing held on January 5, 2018.

RULING #15-MANUEL P. BADILLA (CASE #17GG0151)

Trainer **MANUEL P. BADILLA**, who started the horse **SHYPEN**, winner of the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields, on October 21, 2017, is fined the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, drugs and Other Substances-more than one approved substance; Phenylbutazone (1.85 ug/ml) and Flunixin (4.1 ng/ml) [class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Badilla appeared and stated the small filly Shypen had been treated with Banamine two days prior to the race and Phenylbutazone the day before.
