### FILM REVIEW

Jockey Abel Cedillo appeared to review last Sunday's eighth race where he applied the crop four times without a pause. Cedillo acknowledged the error of his ways and the following ruling was written.

Jockey **ABEL CEDILLO** who rode **ARABESQUE** in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, January 28, 2018 is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense in sixty days).

### REINSTATEMENT

### #34

Unlicensed owner **JESUS B. GARCIA**, having made arrangements to satisfy the outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine, is hereby deemed eligible to be relicensed and Pacific Racing Association ruling #55 dated February 24, 2017 suspending **JESUS B. GARCIA** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is set aside.

The above ruling was composed when the Stewards received written notification that Garcia had signed a payment agreement with San Francisco Equine.

02-01-2018<sup>3</sup>**STEWARDS INQUIRY-SEVENTH RACE-NO CHANGE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review tight quarters and some jostling inside the 1/8 involving three horses. The three involved were #8 Red Glitter (3<sup>rd</sup>, Pedro Flores) on the outside, #4 Papool (4<sup>th</sup>, Heribert Martinez) along the inside and #3 Californiafusaichi (7<sup>th</sup>, Irving Orozco) between the two. After a thorough review the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish.

Tapes showed the three horses driving for the wire when Orozco's mount stepped out and initiated contact with Red Glitter on the outside. This contact turned Red Glitter in and caused the two horses to have further contact. Papool kept a straight path and did not contribute to the situation. Since Californiafusaichi started the incident and then finished behind Red Glitter no action by the Stewards regarding the placings was warranted. Both jockeys will review the films in the morning.

**SATURDAY**02-03-2018<sup>1</sup>**SECOND CHANCE****#35**

Assistant Trainer **WILLIAM J. NOLAN** having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before February 1, 2018 is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874

(Disorderly Conduct), #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) and #1485 (d) (License Subject to Conditions and Agreements).

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **WILLIAM J. NOLAN** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Nolan failed to keep his promise. The original hearing was scheduled for Thursday and Nolan did not appear. He was contacted by phone because the notice to appear was sent to the Alameda County Fairgrounds which is no longer an auxiliary stabling facility. Nolan then promised to come in yesterday morning but didn't make an appearance so the above ruling was put in effect.

**TRUJILLO HEARING (CASE #17GG0171)**

The Stewards conducted an informal hearing for trainer Victor Trujillo after the horse Our Clementine showed the presence of Bute at a level of 15.9 ug/ml following the running of the fifth race on November 23, 2017. Our Clementine got to the wire in front of everybody else.

Victor had no explanation for the test results and all the documentation surrounding the pre-race medication was in order. This is Trujillo's second offense in the past year and second with an excessively high level of permitted medication. This must be factored in when determining a penalty.

**STEWARDS' INQUIRY-JOCKEY OBJECTION-FIRST RACE-NO CHANGE**

The Stewards lit the inquiry lamp to review an incident leaving the 3/8 which saw #3 Ontonome (2<sup>nd</sup>, Heribert Martinez) check sharply while racing inside the winner, #4 Sweet Louisa, ridden by Silvio Amador. Martinez also lodged a claim of foul over the event. After a thorough review the Stewards took no action with respect to the placings.

Tapes showed that approaching the 3/8 Sweet Louisa left plenty of room for Ontonome but when the two reached the elbow Martinez checked his mount. The available camera angles made it impossible to determine if Sweet Louisa put pressure on Ontonome or whether the latter failed to make the turn and went out over Sweet Louisa's heels. Lacking conclusive evidence the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish.

**TRUJILLO RULING**

**#36**

Trainer **VICTOR M. TRUJILLO**, who started the horse **OUR CLEMENTINE**, winner of the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields, on November 23, 2017, is fined the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances-Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level 15.9 ug/ml [class 4]-second offense within a 365 day period).

The preceding ruling was issued following yesterday's hearing. Although it was only a second offense for Mr. Trujillo in the last year both violations showed extremely high levels of medication, hence the penalty imposed above.
