AMADOR RULING

#37

Jockey **SILVIO AMADOR** who rode **RONTON** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, February 4, 2018 is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-second offense in the past sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after Amador appeared and took responsibility for four consecutive strikes with the crop in the stretch drive.

NOLAN HEARING-(CASE #17GG0169 REFERENCE 02/03/2018¹)

William Nolan appeared today to resolve a complaint filed by Investigator Joe Mulligan alleging a blood alcohol content of .05% and traces of Oxycodone in a random test submitted on November 2, 2017. Mr. Nolan had a valid prescription for the Oxycodone. Mr. Nolan had no real reason for failure to appear last week on February 1 or 2, 2018 to address the issues which resulted in his suspension for failure to appear. Original charges were dismissed and the following ruling was issued to resolve the case:

LATE SCRATCH FOURTH RACE

As the horses were leaving the receiving barn headed to the paddock for the fourth race the Stewards were notified that #4 American Pulpit, trained by Jose Puentes, had no hind shoes. Puentes claims he declared shoes off but, neither the entry blank or official overnight noted any change. Paddock Judge Linda Anderson took the entry and does not remember Puentes stating anything about shoes. "American Pulpit" was scratched in violation of California Horse Racing board rule #1843 (Examination Required). Refund was \$1,139.69.

BUCKRIDGE RULING

#39

Trainer **GLORIA J. BUCKRIDGE**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before February 9, 2018, is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting), #1843 (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substances) #1844 (Authorized Medication) and #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **GLORIA J. BUCKRIDGE** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Buckridge failed to appear after being given a continuance from February 2, 2018 to February 9, 2018.

AMADOR RULING

#40

Jockey **SILVIO AMADOR** who rode **MANY MOODS** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, February 10, 2018 is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-third offense in the past sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Amador appeared and admitted that he was trying too hard and forgetting to stop after using the crop three times.

PUENTES RULING (REFER 02/10/2018⁴)

Trainer **JOSE B. PUENTES** is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* for failure to declare at time of entry that the horse **AMERICAN PULPIT** would race unshod necessitating a late scratch in the fourth race on Saturday, February 10, 2018; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (b) (Examination Required).

The above ruling was issued after Puentes appeared and accepted the penalty. He stated that he should have checked the overnight to make sure the shoe change was noted.
