The above ruling was issued after DeLima acknowledged Marino's Wild Cat needed two works to be eligible to start. He stated he worked the horse recently but it did not appear on the work tabs.

The above ruling was issued after Cedillo appeared and readily admitted he exceeded the permitted number of crop placements while in the heat of the battle.

The Stewards conducted a discussion with starter Starter Todd Stephens and both afternoon outriders, Ashton Campoy and Abraham Gonzalez, regarding the time the horses are on the track for the Post Parade.

California Horse Racing Board rules state that the horses shall not be on the track longer than twelve minutes from the time they leave the Paddock until they are dispatched from the Starting Gate. Recently the time on the track, on occasion, has increased to more than fourteen minutes. The purpose of today's meeting was to insure the Post Parade does not stretch beyond the twelve minute limit.

The outriders were instructed to get the horses to the starting gate at post time and the starter was directed to begin the loading process without unnecessary delay.

04-27-2018⁵**LATE SCRATCH-EIGHTH RACE-REFUND**

#6 Major Implication, trained by Bill McLean with Juan Hernandez in the saddle, was scratched on the recommendation of Track Veterinarian Sarah Sporer after she reported the colt became fractious in the starting gate and injured himself. On Veterinarian's List. The refund amounted to \$28,894.98. Jockey Hernandez escaped injury.

04-27-2018⁶**STEWARDS INQUIRY-ACCIDENT-EIGHTH RACE-NO CHANGE**

As the tightly bunched nine horse field entered the stretch driving for the wire #5 Cascadia, ridden by Francisco Duran, fell while racing along the rail and unseated Duran. The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to determine the cause of the accident. After viewing the video replays the Stewards affirmed the original order of finish.

Tapes showed that Cascadia was racing along the rail inside of #2 Sought Bai (8th, Silvio Amador) and appeared to be gaining ground on that rival when he fell at the 1/8. Sought Bai was running inside of #4 Timber Baron (4th, Julien Couton) at the time of the spill. Just before Cascadia fell #9 Kona Breeze (5th, Anne Sanguinetti) running behind and to the outside of Cascadia swerved in and could have contributed to the incident.

As the field neared the 1/8 Sought Bai stepped in slightly which caused tight quarters for Cascadia along the rail. Kona Breeze may have also made contact with Sought Bai's hindquarters which could have sent that horse in toward Cascadia aggravating the situation. It's also possible that Cascadia propped as racing room diminished. With no definitive explanation the Stewards did not take any action with respect to the placings.

Francisco Duran walked back to the Jockey's Room after the accident and was examined by Dr. Seftel who found no serious issues. Jockeys Silvio Amador, Julien Couton, Anne Sanguinetti along with Duran will view the tapes of the race with the Stewards in the morning.

Cascadia exhibited some tenderness following the spill but escaped serious injury.

Jockeys Silvio Amador and Julien Couton viewed the tapes of yesterday's eighth race where an accident occurred. Francisco Duran did not appear as he took off his mounts today and Anne Sanguinetti was absent as she is riding in Seattle.

After viewing the tapes Couton and Amador acknowledged they might have contributed to the incident but the Stewards could not hold either of them solely responsible.

Jockey Hugo Herrera appeared and admitted he struck is mount four times in succession and the following ruling was issued:

Jockey **HUGO HERRERA** who rode **WILDCAT KAOS** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on April 27, 2018 is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond).

MOGER RULINGS (CASES #18GG0017 & 18GG0019)

Trainer **ED MOGER JR.**, who started the horse **LUCKY CLERIC**, winner of the ninth race at Golden Gate Fields, on February 25, 2018, is fined the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication Drugs and Other Substances-Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level 7.08 ug/ml [class 4]-second offense within a 365 day period).

Trainer **ED MOGER JR.**, who started the horse **A WALK IN THE PARK**, fifth place finisher in the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields, on March 3, 2018, is fined the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication Drugs and Other Substances-Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level 5.26 ug/ml [class 4]-third offense within a 365 day period).

The above rulings were issued after Moger signed a waiver of hearing and acknowledged his responsibility under the Trainer Insurer rule. He explained that newly hired grooms and probable feed tub mix-ups were most likely the cause of the high test results.

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **SERGIO PEREZ** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued when Mr. Perez did not show for a scheduled hearing into a complaint filed by San Francisco Equine alleging \$7,851.60 due for veterinary services rendered.

Trainer **BLAINE WRIGHT** is fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)* for failing to have the horse **PULPITS POWER** properly shod for the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday April 28, 2018; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required).

The above ruling was issued after Blaine appeared and explained he forgot to put hind shoes on this horse before sending him over to the Receiving Barn for yesterday's sixth race. The horse shoe inspector, Augustin Reyes, was able to put some shoes on while in the Receiving Barn and the horse was allowed to run.

Exercise Rider Renato Camacho appeared in response to a complaint filed by California Horse Racing Board Investigator Mike Alford alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). On April 1, 2018 Camacho was intoxicated and allegedly struck his wife. Berkeley police arrested Camacho and he has been to court regarding the charges.

The hearing was continued until next Thursday, May 3, 2018 to allow time to gather more information about Camacho and the actions taken by the court.

STEWARDS INQUIRY-ACCIDENT-NINTH RACE-NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to determine why Jockey Irving Orozco became separated from his mount at the 1/16. After a thorough review the Stewards took no actions regarding the placings.

Tapes showed that #3 Grecian Fire, ridden by Orozco, was racing along the rail inside of and behind #4 My Friend Emma with Ricardo Gonzalez in the saddle. Approaching the 1/16 Gonzalez allowed My Friend Emma to drift in and Orozco then shifted his mount to the outside in search of more room. When Irving angled Grecian Fire to the outside he clipped the heels of My Friend Emma. Grecian Fire stumbled which caused Orozco to lose his balance and fall. Both horse and rider escaped injury.
