**THURSDAY**10-18-18<sup>1</sup>**VELASQUEZ RULING****RULING NO # 1**

Jockey **Jesus Velasquez** who rode the mule **Dashing Jack** in the first race at the Big Fresno Fair on Sunday, October 14, 2018 is suspended three (3) racing days (October 25, 26, and 27, 2018) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from

first to fourth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (c) & (e). (Riding Rules-Careless Riding). The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above Ruling was issued after **Velazquez** contacted the Stewards and accepted responsibility for failure to maintain a straight path in this 350 yard Mule race from Fresno. **Velazquez** was disqualified from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>.

**THURSDAY**10-18-2018<sup>2</sup>**REICHEL T HEARING CASE 18SW0036 (REF. 10-13-18<sup>2</sup> Fresno)**

An informal hearing was reconvened today to address **Troy Reichelt's** use of Methamphetamine and his progress in recovery from that addiction. **Darin Scharer** of Winners Foundation was in attendance and produced a signed contract with **Mr. Reichelt** which calls for a minimum of three, 12 Step Recovery meetings a week through March of 2019. **Mr. Reichelt** also produced a letter from "Options Recovery Services" which verified that he completed a 30 day in house Rehabilitation Program. A ruling to address the issues will be forthcoming.

Trainer **Guillermo Preciado** who worked the horse **Meet Ya N Ky** on September 14, 2018 is fined the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing rule # 1866 (b) (1) (Veterinarian's List – may not work a horse for 72 hours after being placed on list – sick).

The above Ruling was issued after **Preciado** appeared and accepted the penalty. He did not realize his horse was on the Vets. List when he worked him.

10-19-18<sup>3</sup> **REICHELTL RULING (REF 10-18-18<sup>2</sup>)**

**RULING NO #3**

Groom **Troy R. Reichelt** is hereby suspended thirty (30) days and placed on probation through March 31, 2022 for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (8) (Grounds For Denial or Refusal of License), #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Use of Methamphetamine) and # 1890 (Possession of Contraband) on August 26, 2018.

Further **Mr. Reichelt** is given credit for time served while completing an In-House rehabilitation program so no further suspension time shall be imposed. Conditions of probation include adhering to a Testing Agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and abiding by the terms of a contract with the Winners Foundation.

The above ruling was issued after yesterday’s hearing confirmed that **Mr. Reichelt** did indeed complete a thirty day in house Rehabilitation Program at Options Recovery Services.

A formal Hearing was conducted today concerning Trainer **Gary Greiner**. **Greiner** is charged with a Phenylbutazone overage of 5.80 ug/ml along with failing to update his Work List and possession of unlabeled medication. Present along with the Board of Stewards were Defendant **Gary Greiner** and Safety Steward **Richard Lewis**. The Case was presented by Investigator **Jennifer Tolman** and recorded by **Christine Niccoli**. **Mr. Greiner** took full responsibility for the

Phenylbutazone overage and the unlabeled medication but thought he had a current worklist on file, It was subsequently discovered that **Mr. Greiner** had a current worklist and that charge was dropped. All documents were entered into the record and the matter deemed submitted, a decision will be forthcoming.

Then as the horses were loading into the gate #5 **My Three Kids** reared in its Stall unseating Jockey **Julien Couton** and got hung up in the starting gate. #5 was declared on the recommendation of Track Veterinarian **Dr. Bill Grantham**. Unfortunately both horses were trained by **Andreas Psarras**. Both jockeys suffered minor injuries and were taken off on the recommendation of Track Physician **Dr. David Seftel**. The Race was delayed for approximately 17 minutes. Total Refund **\$83,636.04**.

Greiner** who started the horse **Diana's Red Wine**, fourth place finisher in the fifth race at the Humboldt County California Horse Racing Fair (Ferndale) on August 17, 2018, is fined the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred dollars (\$2500.00)\* pursuant to Ca Board rule #1887 (Trainer To Insure Condition Of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication Drugs and Other Substances - Phenylbutazone; in excess of permitted level, 5.80 ug/ml [Class 4] - Third Offense in 365 days).

Further, Mr. Greiner is fined the sum of Two Hundred dollars (\$200.00)\* for violation of

California Horse Racing Board rule #1890 (b) (Possession of Contraband – unlabeled medications) on August 31, 2018.

The above Ruling was issued following deliberation over yesterday's Hearing. **Mr. Greiner** was contacted and accepted the penalty without argument.

Apprentice Jockey **Ferrin Peterson** who rode **Not My Money** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on October 20, 2018 is suspended three (3) racing days (October 28, November 1, and 2, 2018) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding). The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Guild Representative Jockey **William Antongeorgi** appeared on behalf of **Ms. Peterson**. **Mr. Antongeorgi** failed to convince this board that the horse was to blame for bearing out in the stretch, since there was no attempt on **Ms. Peterson's** part to keep a straight course. A rival horse was interfered with and a Stewards Review was conducted but since the rival ended up beating her mount there was no cause for an inquiry.
