#### MONROY RULING

##### **RULING NO # 86**

Jockey **Francisco Monroy** who rode **Gambler's Appeal** in the ninth race at **Golden Gate Fields** on **Sunday, May 5, 2019** is fined the sum of **one hundred dollars (\$100.00)\*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond).

The above Ruling was issued after **Mr. Monroy** appeared and reviewed the race with the stewards. He said that he used the crop four times accidentally and vowed to stay out of our office concerning further crop issues.

#### PENCE RULING

##### **RULING NO # 87**

Owner/Groom **Crystal Pence** having complied with the terms and conditions contained in **California State Fair** ruling #14, dated **July 28, 2018**, is hereby restored to good standing and deemed eligible for relicensing.

Further, **Pence** remains on probation for the term of her license (02/28/2021) and as conditions of probation, must adhere to the terms of a contract with the Winners Foundation and a Testing Agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. Failure to comply with the terms of probation will be cause for action against Pence's license privileges.

The above Ruling was issued to clear **Ms. Pence** for licensing and confirm terms of her probation.

5-9-19<sup>3</sup>**3<sup>RD</sup> RACE INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the stretch run of this one mile turf event. After review #1 **Warrior Don (Hugo Herrera)** was disqualified from second and placed 3<sup>RD</sup> for interference to original 3<sup>RD</sup> place finisher #4 **La Guapa Velos (Luis Ocasio)**.

Replays show #1 shift out from behind a tiring leader (#2 **Marina Del Mar**) forcing #4 off its path and costing #4 any chance at a better placing.

5-9-19<sup>4</sup>**5<sup>TH</sup> RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards ordered a review of the start of the 5<sup>TH</sup> Race for the public's benefit. Prohibitive favorite #3 **Snow Cloud (Abel Cedillo)** lifted at the start and broke two lengths last. No interference was detected and since #3 caused its own problem no inquiry was needed.

5-9-19<sup>5</sup>**5<sup>TH</sup> RACE VOIDED CLAIM**

The claim submitted by Trainer **Sam Calvario** for the mare "Kelly" was deemed void after State Veterinarian **Forrest Franklin** reported her lame in her right front leg. "Kelly" was returned to the barn of Trainer **Dan Markle**.

**FRIDAY**5-10-19<sup>1</sup>**HERRERA RULING (REF 5-9-19<sup>3</sup>)****RULING NO # 88**

Jockey **Hugo Herrera** who rode **Warrior Mom** in the third race at **Golden Gate Fields** on **May 9, 2019** is suspended **five (5)** racing days (**May 17, 18, 19, 23 and 24, 2019**) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to third; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding; second offense in the past 60 days) - (**Third offense at this meeting**).

The above ruling was issued after **Herrera** appeared and accepted suspension days for the third time at this meet. He agreed that he made an error by forcing his way out from behind a rival and interfering with another rival. **Mr. Herrera is denied designated race privileges** in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (**Designated Races**) section B which allows that the Stewards may prohibit a jockey from riding in designated races if he/she has been **suspended at least twice during the race meeting**.

5-10-19<sup>3</sup>**2<sup>ND</sup> RACE-TRAINER OBJECTION-NO CHANGE**

Trainer **Jonathan Wong** lodged a claim of foul alleging interference around the turn by the winner #5 **Sneem (Juan Hernandez)** to his horse #6 **Mercy Rule (Abel Cedillo)** who finished third.

After review and talking to the patrol judges and jockeys no change was ordered. Replays showed that #5 was trying to get out around the turn and may have taken a step out mid-turn but the action did not compromise #6's chances.

5-11-19<sup>2</sup>**STEWARDS REVIEW 6<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

The Stewards reviewed the actions of #4 **Sweet Susan B (Luis Ocasio)** and #6 **Simply Perfect (Abel Cedillo)** mid-turn of this five furlong turf event.

Both horses were vying for the lead when #4 appeared to prop and #6 bolted. After thorough review it was determined #6 bolted on its own but #4 actually switched leads repeatedly which led to its dropping back in the field. No reason for an inquiry.

Jockey **Francisco Monroy** who rode **If I Had A Nickel** in the seventh race at **Golden Gate Fields** on **May 11, 2019** is fined the sum of **two hundred dollars (\$200.00)\*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond - second offense in the past sixty days).

The above Ruling was issued after **Monroy** appeared and accepted the penalty. He explained he used the crop four times, one of which was on the shoulder which he rarely does and it put him off his rhythm.

5-12-19<sup>2</sup>**6<sup>TH</sup> RACE INQUIRY - NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the sixth race concerning #1 **River House (Ferrin Peterson)**. After talking to starter **Todd Stephens** and a thorough review of replays at all angles #1 was declared a starter. Replays clearly show that the stall doors opened properly and #1 reared on its own unseating Apprentice Jockey **Peterson**. No change. #1 deemed a starter.
