7-04-07¹ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Martin Garcia appeared before the stewards to review the fourth race on Monday. Mr. Garcia was warned when he is aboard the outside horse, he is the only one able to relieve the pressure on the horses to his inside. He was in full agreement and stated he would be more cognizant in the future.

Jockey Omar Berrio, upon his appearance before the Board, reviewed the eighth race on Monday concerning a precarious situation that he found himself in during the running of the race, which involved running up on heels and looking for a hole that did not exist. Mr. Berrio was warned that despite the fact he only caused trouble to himself, we nonetheless consider this careless riding. He agreed he had made an error in judgment and confirmed it would not occur again.

7-04-07² INQUIRY – NO CHANGE EIGHTH RACE

Following the running of the eighth race the stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review the start of the race. After conversation with Starter Gary Brinson, and further review of the film, the Board of Stewards was in agreement that #10 Unusual Music dwelt on her own accord and was declared a starter.

FORMAL HEARING DURAN CASE #07HP093

Owner Esaul Duran appeared in regard to the complaint alleging a violation of CHRB rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) filed in reference to a security violation notice issued at Santa Anita Race Track. After Mr. Duran felt the necessity to tape the proceedings with his own recorder, the stewards requested court reporter Barbara Weinstein, who was available to record the proceedings.

A decision was made shortly into the hearing to have a continuance after Mr. Duran wanted a recorded testimony (in his son's voice) to be heard as his testimony. Investigator Rick Amieva, who was in attendance, will listen to the recording and set a new date for the hearing so all involved will be able to have their witnesses available.

FORMAL HEARING HOLLYWOOD PARK RACE TRACK
CASE #07HP066

In attendance along with the Board of Stewards and court reporter Barbara Weinstein were Senior Investigator Jim Hamilton, Hollywood Park President F. Jack Liebau, Vice President and Asst. General Manager Eual G. Wyatt Jr., Turf Course Superintendent Bernie Eastridge, and Jockey Richard Migliore. Observing was Supervising Investigator - Southern Region, Bill Westerman.

This hearing pertained to the possible violation of CHRB rule #1469 (Safety of Race Course). On motion by the respondent, CHRB rule #1530 (Cases not Covered by Rules and Regulations) was dismissed from the complaint. After the swearing in of all witnesses, and the examination of testimony from both sides, the hearing was closed. The decision will follow.

O'NEILL RULING

Ruling #87

Trainer Douglas O'Neill, who started the horse Wisdom Cat in the seventh race at Hollywood Park Race Track on May 27, 2006, having entered into a stipulated settlement agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, is fined THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a) and #1843.6(d) (1,2) (Total Carbon Dioxide Testing).

The above ruling was issued after the Stewards' acceptance of the settlement agreement between the California Horse Racing Board and trainer Doug O'Neill. Mr. O'Neill was available telephonically.

COHEN RULING

Ruling #88

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), jockey David Cohen is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for failure to review video tapes when ordered by the Stewards.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Cohen failed to report to the Stewards for the review of films as requested.

INQUIRY - BREAKDOWN FOURTH RACE – NO CHANGE

During the running of the race approaching the quarter pole, #3 Social Slewpy went wrong, unseating jockey Saul Arias. The horse was humanely destroyed on the track and Mr. Arias was transported to the hospital. (Accident report attached).

After a review of the films, it was a unanimous decision by the stewards that no other horses caused this break down.

CANANI RULING – CASE #07HP071

Ruling #89

Trainer Julio Canani is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse Coyote Fast, which ran in the fifth race at Hollywood Park Race Track on June 10, 2007. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse).

CANANI RULING – CASE #07HP072

Ruling #90

Trainer Julio Canani, who started the horse Kris' Sis in the first race at Hollywood Park Race Track on June 2, 2007, is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1844 (Authorized Medication – medication in excess of permitted level – Phenylbutazone).

The above two rulings were issued after an informal hearing with Mr. Canani, who felt he should be held blameless for both complaints. The Stewards could not agree with any of his arguments as to why he should not be penalized.

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE THIRD RACE

Subsequent to the running of the race, the Stewards illuminated the inquiry sign to review a possible infraction past the quarter pole. Involved were #3 Passified (1st Mike Smith) and #4 Spenditallbaby (3rd Joseph Talamo). After a review of the films, and conversation with the patrol judge, it was a unanimous decision that there was mutual contact between both horses; thus the original order of finish went unchanged.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Martin Garcia joined the Stewards to review the fourth race on Friday to discuss the importance of straightening his mount more quickly leaving the gate. Mr. Garcia was informed that further neglect of this action will result in a penalty. He declared he will be more mindful in the future and thanked us for our advice.

Jockey David Cohen, at the request of the Stewards, came to the office to review the eighth race on 7-01-07. The Stewards emphasized that the horse on the outside is the only one capable of relieving the pressure on the inside horses. Mr. Cohen agreed and promised to be more vigilant next time.

HARRIS INFORMAL HEARING CASE #07HP063

After minimal negotiating, Mr. Harris paid Mr. Block (Centurion Systems) \$806.00 and agreed to pay the remaining \$194.00 by August 1st, for the “Therapulse” blanket, which will then be paid for in full.

BIANCONE RULING

Ruling #91

Trainer Patrick Biancone is fined FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845(a) (Authorized Bleeder Medication) at Hollywood Park on July 6, 2007 (2nd offense).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Biancone telephonically admitted that he dropped the ball in regards to turning in the proper medication document to the receiving barn prior to his entry.

BREAKDOWN – SECOND RACE

Approaching the quarter pole, #2 Grand Point (jockey Victor Espinoza) went wrong and was pulled up promptly. The horse was transported back to its stable for further evaluation from the trainer's practicing veterinarian.

ORMSBY RULING CASE #07HP073

Ruling #92

Owner Monty Ormsby, having failed to appear before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of Monty Ormsby are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1527 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Fine or Suspend), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Ormsby failed to appear on the date set for his hearing.

COHEN RULING

Ruling #93

Jockey David Cohen is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) on July 7, 2007.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Cohen admitted his guilt in not arriving at the jockey quarters at the proper scheduled time. His reason was that he was not aware of the 12:00PM post time.

RAMIREZ RULING

Ruling #94

Outrider MARCO RAMIREZ is fined fifty dollars (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) on June 28, 2007 at Hollywood Park Race Track.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Ramirez admitted to leaving his pony horse in an outrider's pen after the Stall Superintendent had denied his request to do so.

PURSE REDISTRIBUTION RULING CASE #05SA246

Ruling #95

Based upon an order by the California Horse Racing Board and a report from University of California, Davis Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #R15943, obtained from the horse KOOL SUGGESTION, the second place finisher in the seventh race at Oak Tree Racing Association, Santa Anita Race Track on October 12, 2005, contained the class 2 drug substance 2-hydroxyethyl-promazine, a metabolite of acepromazine above the authorized decision level, it is ordered that KOOL SUGGESTION be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the purse money earned in said race (\$10,00.00) be returned by owners Heaton Stable LLC (Carl and Shannon Heaton) and Carl Van Burger to the Paymaster of Purses by August 8, 2007, and be redistributed in accordance with the revised order of finish.

Revised Order of Finish

- 1st – Proud Tower Too
- 2nd – Super Strut
- 3rd – Uncle Denny
- 4th – Ata Olympio

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), neither the pari-mutuel payout nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.

The above ruling was issued after the Stewards received the Notice of Non Action from the California Horse Racing Board in relation to the finding of the positive test result of the horse "Kool Suggestion".

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE FIRST RACE

Following the running of the race, the Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review a possible incident approaching the finish line between #2 Royal Classic (1st Martin Pedroza) and #5 Spriggzee (2nd Corey Nakatani). After reviewing the films, talking to the Patrol Judge and both jockeys involved, it was in the Stewards opinion that the slight float did not warrant a disqualification and the original order of finish remained the same.

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE EIGHTH RACE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign after the finish of the race to review a possible infraction nearing the wire between #1 Celtic Dreamin ((2nd Corey Nakatani) and #5 Latin Rhythms (1st Jose Valdivia Jr.). After reviewing the films, talking to the Patrol Judge and both jockeys it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand. In the Stewards' opinion, the light contact between the horses did not justify a disqualification.
