MINUTES – THIRD WEEK of HOLLYWOOD PARK SPRING MEETING

WEDNESDAY
05/07/08¹

WRIGHT RULING

HRTH #11

HRTH Ruling #49, issued at Hollywood Park Racing Association on December 14, 2007, is set aside as exercise rider ROBERT WRIGHT, currently unlicensed, has failed to abide by a signed financial agreement with San Luis Rey Downs, and is therefore in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility).

The above referenced ruling was issued after the Board of Stewards received confirmation from San Luis Rey Downs that Mr. Wright had failed to abide by a previously signed financial agreement.

CRAIGMYLE HEARING – CASES #08SA146, #08HP006 and #08HP008

Present at the informal hearing along with Mr. Craigmyle and the Board of Stewards was Senior Investigator Rick Amieva, representing the California Horse Racing Board. The alleged violations were in reference to CHRB rules # 1843 (a) (d) (Medication, Drug and Other Substances Permitted After Entry) and # 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) involving two Trenbolone (Class IV) medication violations wherein both occurred within an eight day period.

Mr. Craigmyle explained that both of the horses involved had been purchased last fall privately. After investigating the drug Trenbolone on the internet, he surmised that the drug had been administered prior to the purchase, and was still in the horse's systems when he raced them. After conversation with Dr. Connor, Mr. Craigmyle decided both horses would be re-tested before they pass the entry box.

The third case adjudicated concerned a Phenylbutazone overage. Mr. Craigmyle revealed that this incident was possible, as the horse involved did not promptly clean up the night feed which contained the medication.

The following ruling was issued for the Phenylbutazone overage. A decision for the Trenbolone positive will follow.

HRTH #12 -CASE: 08HP006

Trainer KEITH CRAIGMYLE, who started the horse "El Navigante" which finished second in the first race at Santa Anita Park on April 11, 2008, is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$400.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1844 (C -1) (Authorized Medication –Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level).

INQUIRY –FIRST RACE – NO CHANGE

Upon completion of the first race, the stewards posted the inquiry sign to review a possible infraction which occurred in mid-stretch. Involved were #3 Elusive Chief (2nd M. C. Baze), #4 Hold That Exposure (4th M. Garcia), and #8 Devil Maker (3rd C. Nakatani). The majority decision (Steward Sawyer dissented) was that the contact between the three horses was contributed to mutually; hence the original order of finish was made official.

BARBA RULING –CASE #08HP003

HRTH # 13

Trainer ALEXIS BARBA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Late) and #1894 (Duties of a Trainer) with her horse DR. J J on April 23, 2008 at Hollywood Park.

The ruling referenced above was issued after a telephone hearing with Ms. Barba, wherein she accepted full responsibility for the tardiness. She pledged to reorganize the routine at her barn to prevent a recurrence.

CRAIGMYLE RULING –COMBINED: CASE #08SA146, CASE #08HP008

HRTH Ruling #14

Trainer KEITH CRAIGMYLE, who started the horse “Light Up My Heart” which finished unplaced in the first race at Santa Anita Park on April 3, 2008, and the horse “El Navigante”, which finished second in the first race at Santa Anita Park on April 11, 2008, is fined TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS* (\$2,000.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (A) & (C) (Medication, Drugs, and Other Substances – Trenbolone –Class IV).

This ruling was issued after post-hearing deliberation. The stewards felt the penalty was justified due to the fact that Trenbolone is not only a class IV drug about to be updated as a class III, but its intended use is specifically for cattle. Mr. Craigmyle accepted the penalty without argument.

REED RULING – CASE #08HP007

HRTH Ruling #15

Groom TRACY REED, having failed to appear before the Board of Stewards to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of Tracy Reed are suspended, and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1527 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Fine or Suspend), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The ruling above was issued after Ms. Reed failed to appear to address the complaint filed by the CHRB.

GREELY RULING – CASE #08HP001

HRTH Ruling #16

Trainer BEAU GREELEY is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Late) and #1894 (Duties of Trainer) with his horse “Three Park Night” on April 25, 2008 at Hollywood Park.

The fourth ruling of the day was issued after Mr. Greely telephonically accepted the penalty. He had no excuse; his only justification was having two horses in the same race may have slowed down his grooms’ procession to the receiving barn.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Alonso Quinonez came before the stewards as directed to review the eighth race on May 7, 2008; Mr. Quinonez was cautioned that if he chooses to ride in tight quarters he must have more control of his mount. He agreed, and stated he would be more cognizant in the future.

Jockey Mike Smith also appeared to review the third race on May 4, 2008 wherein he created a narrow margin of clearance when positioning himself into the first turn of the 1 1/16 mile turf route. He stated he was not aware of the horse to his inside and he would be more mindful in the future.

JOCKEY MEETING

The Board of Stewards met in the jockey quarters to review incidents that occurred during the previous week. Riding here at Hollywood Park has been generally clean and without mishaps. The jockey colony is evidently in agreement, as no riders were present at the meeting. This raises the question as to whether or not the jockeys find these gatherings necessary.

NET JET MACHINES

The Board of Stewards received a call from the stewards in Northern California regarding a problem with a particular brand of wagering machine on Kentucky Derby day. Apparently, the quick pick wagering format on the Net Jet machines failed to include the bottom horse on any of its automatically generated tickets.

This Board of Stewards contacted Hollywood Park Pari-Mutuel Manager Robert Poole, who was already aware of the situation and explained that this system had been suspended in California until the problem with the software was resolved. We are also informed that Sacramento had initiated an investigation into the circumstances surrounding this error.

ACCIDENT / JOCKEY OBJECTION / SECOND RACE – NO CHANGE

Entering the stretch while in the clear, #6 He's A Handful (Martin Garcia) under a left handed whip, made a right turn, unseating the rider. No other horses were involved. Accident report attached.

Jockey Matt Garcia aboard #5 Fil's Regent (3rd) lodged a claim of foul against #4 Cat Dreamer (1st M. Pedroza) for alleged interference near the 5/16 pole. After conversation with the Patrol Judge and both jockeys involved, the decision to make the original order of finish official was unanimous. It was the opinion of the Stewards that #5 was bothered briefly but was not cost an opportunity at a better placing.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Panza telephoned the Board of Stewards stating he had no excuse for the racing office’s mistake, and in the future he would hold each individual staff member involved accountable.

Hollywood Park Racing Association is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1461 (Duty to Compile Official Program – failure to note first-time gelding).

INQUIRY FOURTH RACE – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the fourth race, the inquiry sign was lit to review a possible infraction approaching the 1/8 pole between #4 Awesome Graf (3rd Martin Garcia), #9 Kbello (1st A. Gryder) and #12 Stomp Dance (2nd R. Bejarano).

After discussion with the Patrol Judge and all jockeys involved, the vote was unanimous to let the original order of finish stand. The films show that #4 did initiate first contact with #12; that being said, #12 finished in front of #4, making the issue moot. #9 drifted out slightly at the wire but that did not affect the outcome of the race.

URIBE RULING

HRTH #19

Jockey MARIO URIBE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) and placed on probation for the term of his license (1/09) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – intoxication and failure to cooperate with stable gateman). Additionally, subject is ordered to sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and comply with the guidelines set forth by the Winner's Foundation.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Uribe came to the Stewards' office to explain his alleged actions which occurred pursuant to a security violation issued on May 7, 2008. His clean record was taken into consideration when the penalty was handed down.

INQUIRY - ACCIDENT / SIXTH RACE, CUSHION TRACK – NO CHANGE

As the field crossed the finish line the inquiry sign was posted to review two different incidents. The first involved #9 Celtic Rose (D. Flores), who bolted at the top of the stretch and was then pulled up by jockey Flores. Both were unharmed and no other horses were involved.

The second incident happened approaching the 1/16 pole, where #8 Miss Cozy Cat (M. Smith) went wrong, falling and unseating her jockey. The #7 Scout About (A. Solis) unseated her rider upon running into and stumbling over #8. Mike Smith was excused from his final mount. Alex Solis was examined by First Aid and was released to ride his remaining assignments. The #7 horse was euthanized on track. Accident reports attached.

INQUIRY / SEVENTH RACE – NO CHANGE

The inquiry sign was lit again after the seventh race to review a possible infraction in late stretch involving #6 Sweeter Still (IRE) (1st Martin Garcia) and #8 Magical Fantasy (2nd A. Solis). It was a majority vote (Steward Sawyer dissented) that even though #6 did drift out down the lane, #8 also drifted out under left handed urging. There was slight contact between the two horses but the majority vote felt it happened close enough to the finish that it did not affect the outcome of the race.

HORSE AMBULANCE PROCEDURE MEETING

Due to the fact that there was a delay in the arrival of the horse ambulance which was sent to attend to a breakdown on Saturday (ref. 05/10/08³), a meeting was assembled to discuss procedures to prevent a repeat incident. In attendance at the meeting were Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur D.V.M., Vice President / General Manager of Hollywood Park Eual G. Wyatt, Jr., Track Surface Consultant Dennis Moore, Track Veterinarian Jill Bailey D.V.M., and State Veterinarian Tim Connor D.V.M.

Immediately following the actual accident, Steward Chaney radioed for the horse ambulance to respond to the scene. The transmission was heard by everyone on that frequency except the horse ambulance crew, thus creating the delay. It was suggested that in the future, once the ambulance is aware of any mishap, they start onto the track; if there is a substantial amount of dead air time on the radio, they will then initiate conversation. The stewards will make sure visually that the ambulance is moving immediately. Also, management will replace any faulty radios. These measures will be implemented immediately.

Jockey RAMON DOMINGUEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) on May 10, 2008.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Dominguez was made aware of the penalty. Mr. Dominguez missed his first mount due to an airport delay.

HRTH #21

Trainer PETER EURTON is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Late) and #1894 (Duties of Trainer) with his horse “Bran Jammass” on April 23, 2008 at Hollywood Park.

The ruling referenced above was issued after Mr. Eurton telephoned with his explanation for the tardiness to the receiving barn. Apparently an equipment malfunction at departure time caused the delay.

JONES RULING – CASE #08HP011

HRTH #22

Trainer MARTIN F. JONES is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$500.00) for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse “Anatolian Gold” which ran in the fourth race at Hollywood Park Race Track on April 26, 2008. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Jones telephoned the stewards, taking full responsibility for not reporting his first time gelding. He said he would surely pay more attention in the future.

GAINES RULING – CASE #08HP012

HRTH #23

Trainer CARLA GAINES is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS* (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Late) and #1894 (Duties of Trainer) with her horses “River Glow” and “Tiz Elemental” on April 27, 2008 at Hollywood Park.

This ruling was issued after Ms. Gaines offered an explanation for two runners in the same race arriving late to the receiving barn. She took full responsibility, stating she had eight entries that day and everyone was extremely busy.

GARCIA RULING

Ruling #24 was issued after Mr. Garcia met with the stewards to review the sixth race from May 10, 2008. Mr. Garcia felt he gave his best effort in guiding his horse; the Board of Stewards did not agree, resulting in the following suspension:

Jockey MARTIN GARCIA is suspended for three (3) racing days (May 18, 21, and 22, 2008), for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch while riding "Sweeter Still" in the seventh race at Hollywood Park on Saturday, May 10, 2008. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) and (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

FIRST RACE DELAY

The computer for the film patrol cameras crashed about two minutes prior to post for the first race. They were up and running with horses loading into the starting gates at 1:24 p.m., thus creating an approximate four minute delay.

INQUIRY – NINTH RACE - DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was posted to review a possible incident in late stretch, involving #6 Distant Victory (3rd V. Espinoza) and #7 Bea's Cee (2nd R. Migliore). The films verified that #7 drifted out causing #6 – who was in between horses – to take up for two strides. After conversation with the Patrol Judge and both riders involved, it was the stewards' unanimous opinion that #6, who came back on to be beaten only a nose for second, lost all chance at a better placing. Therefore #7 was disqualified from second and placed third behind #6.
