An informal hearing was conducted to review a financial complaint filed by trainer JOSEPH GLORIOSO against owner Christina Buchanan, both of whom were present. Ms. Buchanan's husband, JOE MARTINEZ, who is involved with Mr. Glorioso in a separate investment, also attended.

All testimony was heard, and Ms. Buchanan presented evidence that she had paid Mr. Glorioso more than the amount requested in the complaint. Therefore, the decision to dismiss the case was unanimous.

DETENTION BARN ISSUE

Trainer DOUG O’NEILL begins his sixty day penalty in the detention barn today. Hollywood Park President Jack Liebau feels the track should not be required to enforce the penalty; TOC President Drew Couto contends O’Neill’s starters should be placed in detention.

Mr. O'Neill is opposed to serving this penalty without a hearing, but has agreed to initiate the process due to the pressure that is being applied to Hollywood Park.

JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the third race (1 1/8 turf) jockey Corey Nakatani, who rode #2 E Z Dreamer (2nd), lodged an objection against #3 Tiz West (V. Espinoza 1st) for a possible infraction down the backstretch. After conversations with both jockeys and the Patrol Judge, and a review of all available angles of the race, the original order of finish was allowed to stand by unanimous decision.

JOCKEY OBJECTION - NO CHANGE

Following the finish of the ninth race, jockey Corey Nakatani, rider of fourth place finisher #5 Silar Rules, lodged a claim of foul against #8 Victory Dancer (2nd A. Quinonez) for a possible infraction turning for home. After speaking with both riders and the Patrol Judge, the stewards' agreed that no change was necessary. The two horses did make contact; #5 came out slightly, tipping #8 as he was shifting inward, but the stewards' felt the blame could be shared between both runners.
