CAVINESS HEARING

Pony rider Pam Caviness contacted the office by telephone to discuss case number 10SA102. On February 25th, 2010 Ms. Caviness' pony horse got loose from the stable area and ran onto the track during the 2nd race. The outrider chased after the loose horse and was able to get control of the horse without causing any interference with the race. Ms. Caviness had been previously warned not to tie her pony up near the quarter chute gap. She acknowledged her mistake, and assured us that she would not let it happen again. The following ruling was issued:

Pony rider **PAM CAVINESS** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers-unsecured pony horse).

Dr. Taraba came in the Stewards' office to informally discuss case number 10SA131 filed by Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey. Films clearly revealed that #4 Rockstar Ben did lug out badly and interfere with his rival but in the unanimous opinion of the stewards, #7 Steel Blue was not cost the two and a quarter lengths that she was beaten for second. Therefore, no change was appropriate.
