MANARINO RULING

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Christian Reyes met with the Stewards to discuss his use of the whip in the first race yesterday. After the field of horses passed him in upper stretch Mr. Reyes hit his horse, which had already exerted its best effort, six times. Mr. Reyes had no reason for this action, but stated he was not hitting his mount hard. He now knows this style is against the CHRB rules and will not be tolerated. Thus the following ruling was issued:

CRAIGMYLE HEARING CASE #10HP053

This informal hearing pertained to a possible violation of CHRB rule # 1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). Mr. Craigmyle testified that his trainee had been tattooed and identified at Los Alamitos Race Track and at that time a gelding notation was placed on the foal certificate by the Horse Identifier Juan M. Garcia. A copy of the foal papers was on file at Hollywood Park when the horse was entered, but the sex of the horse had not properly been entered into the computer system at Los Alamitos. When the papers were delivered to the Clerk of the Course at Hollywood Park, the programs had already been printed and the change was announced when wagering opened. Decision to follow.

Mr. Craigmyle also had a complaint (case 10HP085) filed by Dr. Bailey pertaining to a possible violation CHRB rule 1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn) and 1894 (Duties of Trainer). Mr. Craigmyle agreed to go forward with the complaint early. He testified that he had arrived on time to the receiving barn, but one of his trainees had lost a shoe which needed to be replaced, thus causing the delay in departure from the Receiving Barn. Decision to follow.

PALMA HEARING CASE #10HP006

A formal hearing was held by the Board of Stewards and recorded by court reporter Barbara Weinstein. Trainer Hector Palma was unavailable to attend, but gave permission telephonically to proceed with the hearing. This case involved a possible violation of CHRB rule # 1844(c) (1) (Authorized Medication) and CHRB rule # 1866 (Veterinarian’s List). Mr. Palma stated prior to the hearing that the horse in question had received two Phenylbutazone pills the day before the workout to be removed from the Veterinarian’s List. Because of Mr. Palma’s untarnished record he qualified for a warning in accordance with category “C” penalties for rule 1844 (c) (1) (2) (3). An official warning was issued.

The above ruling was issued after Ms. Rodriguez had failed to make any of the first three prearranged payments.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Miller took full responsibility for the violations.

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. Involved were # 1 Lucky Sis (5th M. Pedroza) and # 2 Actual Size (6th J. Rosario). After a review of the video it was a unanimous decision to disqualify #1 and place her sixth and last behind #2. It was the Stewards' opinion that when #1 broke out at the start, # 2 clipped her heels and was denied all chances of a better placing.
