The above ruling was issued after jockey Joel Rosario was informed of the penalty given due to his inability to fulfill his riding engagements because of travel arrangements.

INQUIRY SIXTH RACE (5 ½ Furlongs-Cushion)NO CHANGE

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review a possible infraction near the eighth pole. Involved in the four horse spread were, on the inside #4 Dee Dee's Legacy (2nd J. Talamo), next out #10 Get Off The Sugar (9th M. Pedroza) next out #12 Quoted (10th F. Valdez), and on the outside was #6 Night Justice (3rd P. Valenzuela). After a review of the videos and conversation with the

Patrol Judges and all riders involved the Stewards unanimously agreed to let the original order of finish stand. It was the Stewards' opinion that # 10 drifted out into #12, #4 followed #12 out and then straightened up. At the same time #6 on the outside was brushed by #12 and was tipped inward. The combination of events caused #10 and #12 to take up but it did not affect their placing.

GARCIA FORMAL HEARING CASE #100T028

This case was filed for a violation of CHRB rules 1844 (c) (Authorized Medication) and 1866 (Veterinarian's List). Court Reporter Lynn Medina recorded the hearing. Senior Special Investigator Jim Hamilton represented the CHRB and respondent trainer Victor Garcia represented himself. The horse "Lauren C" had a Phenylbutazone overage (5.75 ug/ml) after an AM work out to be removed from the "Vet's List". Mr. Garcia stated the horse had been treated by his practicing veterinarian the morning before the workout and his only explanation for the overage is the horse received feed that contained the medication in an accidental switch of feed tubs. Mr. Garcia, not having any priors of a Phenylbutazone positive and in accordance with the medication guidelines under category "C" Penalties is eligible for, and received, an official warning.
