FILM REVIEW

Jockey Garrett Gomez joined the Stewards to review the fourth race yesterday. The Stewards felt Mr. Gomez made an aggressive move to maintain an inadvisable position entering the first turn. Mr. Gomez stated he would not have made this decision if the race had been a claimer, but felt his move was justified. He was informed that what he did was not a rule violation, but we were concerned it was not a safe decision. After a good discussion we agreed to disagree.

FULMER RULING

This ruling was issued after Mr. Fulmer's horse started yesterday. Mr. Fulmer registered his horse after the entry time.

Trainer **DREW C. FULMER** is fined **THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication-late registration) in the fifth race at Hollywood Park on July 9, 2011.

FIRST RACE INCIDENT

During the running of the race # 5 Naughty Mariana was eased and pulled up near the 3/8 marker. First report given to the on track Racing Veterinarian Dana Stead by jockey Patrick Valenzuela, was the horse felt off behind. Soon after, Dr. Stead informed the Stewards that Mr.

Valenzuela changed his opinion of the horse's condition (the horse was okay), rather, that Valenzuela himself had body cramps and was unable to finish the race. This is a rare occurrence; Mr. Valenzuela had been involved in a spill during the Friday night program, but was cleared to ride Sunday by the track physician. He will have to be re-examined by a doctor before he is allowed to ride.

FOURTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident inside the 1/16 marker. Involved were #2 Balladry (2nd R. Bejarano) and #8 Maestro (1st J. Talamo). After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol Judges and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision that # 8 drifted out bumping #2, pushing him off his path. Given the fact that # 2 was beaten a nose for the win, the Stewards felt that he lost the opportunity at a better placing. # 8 was disqualified and placed second behind #2. The #1 horse Coming Thru (4th M. Garcia) was slightly involved in the three horse spread. This horse shifted out when #2 moved out. It was the Stewards' opinion that this horse was not cost an opportunity for a better placing.

TALAMO RULING

This ruling was issued after Mr. Talamo met with the Stewards to discuss the disqualification in the fourth race Sunday. It was the majority opinion that Mr. Talamo had four strides to correct his outward drift before the infraction occurred; Steward Chaney felt that the blame could be attached to the horse.

HRTH #071

Jockey **JOSEPH TALAMO** is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (July 24, 27, and 28, 2011) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, and causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount "Maestro" in the fourth race at Hollywood Park on July 10, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

MOSS MEETING

Owner Jerry Moss requested a meeting with the BOS to discuss the disqualification of his horse "Maestro" in Sunday's fourth race. Also in attendance was his stable manager, Dotty Ingordo-Shirreffs. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui and Vic Stauffer sat in as observers. Mr. Moss had questions about the reasoning behind the disqualification of his horse and wanted to compare a decision that was made in the fifth race at Hollywood Park on December 3, 2010. This involved an inquiry that was posted, but Mr. Moss's horse, who had been involved, was not moved up.

There was a good discussion with respect to how this BOS applies its interpretation of CHRB rule 1699 to decisions made when riding infractions occur. Mr. Moss appreciated our explanation and thanked us for our time.

KITCHINGMAN FORMAL HEARING CASE #11HO062

The case filed against trainer Adam Kitchingman under CHRB rules 1581.1 (Entries) and 1588 (g) (Horse Ineligible to Start in a Race) was recorded by court reporter Barbara Weinstein. Representing the CHRB was Investigator Jim Hamilton. Also in attendance before the BOS were trainer Adam Kitchingman and Vic Stauffer, who was sitting in as an observer. After sworn testimony and having moved all documents into evidence the hearing was closed.

The horse "Swordsmanship" was entered to race on June, 12 2011. Assistant Starter Keil Travis informed the BOS that said horse did not have the Starter's approval to start in a race. After receiving this information a scratch card was posted in the Racing Secretary's Office. Mr. Kitchingman, who at the time of entry was out of the country, was sent a text from jockey agent Craig O'Byan asking if he had a horse

available to make a six horse field for an overnight stake race. Mr. Kitchingman stated he contacted his assistant trainer, asked if the horse was in racing condition and he was told yes. He then allowed Mr. O'Bryan to enter said horse. When Mr. Kitchingman returned to his stable, he discovered the horse had sore shins. He then called the Receiving Barn to file a scratch card and was informed that the horse had already been declared from the race by the Stewards.

In a majority decision the BOS decided there was not enough evidence to penalize Mr. Kitchingman for any wrong doing and dismissed the case. Steward Sawyer felt a penalty was appropriate.

This financial complaint was filed by Southern California Equine Foundation, Inc. in the amount of \$ 277.50 for half the fee of a nuclear scan against owner Thomas Vanmeter. Mr. Vanmeter's trainer, Bruce Headley, had paid half of the bill when it was due. Mr. Vanmeter was available by telephone from his home in Kentucky. He agreed that the money was owed, but due to a previous agreement with Mr. Headley he felt that Mr. Headley was responsible for the outstanding balance and he was going to call Mr. Headley and try to resolve this matter. Two minutes after the ninth race was made official, the Stewards noticed that the numbers on the tote board were wrong. The mutuel department was immediately notified to cancel payouts of the superfecta combination of 5-4-8-7. At the same time the Stewards told the placing judges to replace # 7 (4th) with # 6, the correct numbers 5-4-8-6 were posted. Simultaneously, announcer Vic Stauffer was told to inform the public to hold all tickets, there had been an error and he explained the correction to the public. The incorrect combination dollar payoff was \$847.80, ten cent

payoff, \$84.78. The correct combination payoff for one dollar was \$611.30; ten cent payoff was \$61.13.
