FILM REVIEW

CHRISTIAN SANTIAGO REYES came to the office as directed to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday in which his horse drifts out at the 5/16ths pole and causes another horse to check sharply. Mr. Reyes explained that the horse was getting out badly the entire race, that his arm was tired, and that the horse got away from him briefly. The majority could not discern a reasonable effort to keep his mount in and therefore believed that a three suspension days were in order. Steward Ward believed that the horse was to blame and therefore voted for a pass.

HRTH #031

Jockey **CHRISTIAN SANTIAGO REYES** is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (November 26, 27, and December 1, 2011) for altering course without sufficient clearance approaching the quarter pole and causing interference aboard "Neurosurgeon" in the sixth race at Hollywood Park on November 19, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ came to the office to review his ride in the seventh race on Friday night in which his mount drifted a step going into the far turn to make contact with the horse to his inside. Although the

horse to his inside was in an inadvisable spot and the horse to Mr. Gutierrez's outside did put some pressure on him, nevertheless, we advised him to be more careful in the future. He agreed.

RACES CANCELLATION

Shortly before the running of the sixth race, we received a call from Jockeys' Guild representative Darrell Haire explaining that the jockeys had some concern about the safety of the racetrack, particularly on the back stretch. We alerted Hollywood Park management and the trackman.

After the sixth race, we held a meeting in the jockeys' room in which the colony explained that the rain over the last several hours had made the backstretch deep, that there was no drainage, no "bottom" to the race track, and that horses were slipping or not getting a hold of the track. In their opinion, the track was unsafe and could not be fixed to salvage the last three races of the day, the races were therefore cancelled. At that point, we discussed with Eual Wyatt and the mutuel manager what CHRB rules and regulations required in terms of payoffs and refunds for existing wagers. After that, an announcement was made and the appropriate parties were notified.
