HOLLENDORFER RULING

HRT# #046

Trainer **JERRY HOLLENDORFER** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to have his horse "Life Is a Rock" properly shod for the first race on December 7, 2011.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Hollendorfer was informed that this was his second offense (first offense is a warning) within a calendar year pertaining to the arrival of his horse to the Receiving Barn with toe grabs on when entered to race on the turf. Fortunately the Receiving Barn Plater was able to grind off the toe grabs, thus allowing the horse to race.

There was an approximate eight minute delay in making the third race official due to a software issue with QDC in Sacramento. After the correction was made the rest of the day was performed on time.

Racing Form and at the end of the condition header in the program. The correction was posted on the television scroll and was continually announced throughout the afternoon.

RIVER OF DREAMS" in the fourth race at the Los Angeles County Fair on September 25, 2011, is suspended for **THIRTY (30) days (December 26, 2011 through January 24, 2012)** and fined **THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)*** pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule # 1887(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California

Horse Racing Board rule #1844(c)(9)(f)(Authorized Medication-Clenbuterol (Class 3) in excess of permitted levels-602 pg/ml blood and 65 ug/ml urine).
