JOCKEYS IN

Jockey JOSE VALDIVIA JR. was in this morning to review the second race on Saturday, when his horse #4 "Noble Kent" came in slightly and made contact with #6 "You Know I Know" approaching the half mile pole. Mr. Valdivia stated that he did not know that Mr. Quinonez was inside of him, and he stated that he will be more aware in the future. We felt this issue did not warrant a penalty, so a warning was issued.

Jockeys ALONSO QUINONEZ and VICTOR ESPINOZA were also in to review the second race on Saturday during which their horses made contact several times down the stretch. Both riders acknowledged their mistakes and promised to make a better effort in the future. A warning was issued.

Jockey KEVIN KRIGGER was in the office to review Saturday's tenth race, the Mervyn Leroy Handicap, during which his mount #9 "Honour the Deputy" was disqualified from fifth place and placed last. Mr. Krigger stated his horse shifted out from a left handed urging, in which he quickly corrected him. We felt the jockey should not be penalized because he only hit his horse one time and therefore he was simply warned.

Jockey OMAR BERRIO was in the office this morning to see us regarding failure to report his weight in a timely matter. Mr. Berrio stated that his

ride to the track was late to pick him up. Mr. Berrio was warned to call us the next time the issue comes up.

WALTHER SOLIS

Trainer WALTHER SOLIS met with the us in the Stewards' office for a formal hearing regarding a complaint (case #12SA129) filed by the CHRB alleging violation of CHRB rules 1844C(2)(Authorized Medication) and 1887(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). On March 25, 2012 the post race sample of one of Mr. Solis' horse, "Oh Righty" contained an excess amount of the class 4 drug "Flunixin" (32.95NG/ML). Senior Investigator Jim Hamilton represented the CHRB and recording the hearing was court reporter Barbara Weinstein. Mr. Solis stated that the overage could have come from his practicing veterinarian, when he accidentally mixed up the medications. The exhibits were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Ruling to follow.

LATE SCRATCHES

Two horses on Sunday's race card had to be scratched. In the fifth race #1 Span Jet and in the ninth race #11 Silic's Valley were scratched due to insufficient workouts. Both horses came from the San Luis Rey Downs Training Center which is not recognized as a Bet Fair Hollywood Park auxiliary stabling site. More on this issue in the future.

STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign after the sixth race when jockey Kevin Krigger, aboard #6 Chukchi Sunrise, was unseated leaving the starting gate. After speaking with Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the incident, we unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish. The video shows that the horse stumbled on his own, causing Mr. Krigger to be unseated. The jockey was unharmed; fortunately he landed on his feet running, literally running.

SOLIS RULING

Pursuant to the Solis hearing Sunday (see above), we published the following ruling:

HRTH #006

Trainer **WALTHER SOLIS**, who started the horse "Oh Righty", the 1st place finisher in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on March 25, 2012, is fined **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)*** pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843(a)(d)(Medications, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844(c)(2)(Authorized Bleeder Medication-Flunixin in excess of permitted level-32.95 ng/ml).

MEDINA REHEARING

We held a formal hearing this morning into an appeal by jockey JESSIE MEDINA. The CHRB remanded the case to us, requiring that she be afforded another opportunity for representation. This time she brought jockey Edwin Maldonado and Jockeys' Guild representative Darrell Haire to argue the case. We heard oral testimony and watched the film of the race again. The hearing was closed and a decision will follow.

Apprentice jockey OSVALDO MACIAS was called in to our office to explain why he was late to the paddock for Thursday's second race. The apprentice stated it was his first mount here at Betfair Hollywood Park and that he got lost in the tunnels going to the paddock. We advised him to follow his fellow riders in the future. The apprentice was issued a warning.
