FILM REVIEW

Apprentice jockey ESWAN FLORES came to the office today to review his ride in the second race yesterday in which his mount was disqualified from first and placed second. After reviewing the race, he recognized that his error was when he continued to strike his horse left-handed while he was drifting out. For this mistake, he was issued the following ruling:

HRTH #018

Apprentice jockey **ESWAN FLORES** is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (June 3, 7, and 8, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount "Living Our Dream" from first to second place in the second race at Hollywood Park on May 27, 2012. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the fifth race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine the start of the race in which #1 Yomybato (Jose Valdivia jockey)

stumbled, causing his rider to lose both irons. After examining the replays and speaking to the starter, it was our unanimous decision to make no change and declare the horse a starter, as he created his own problems and poor start.

QUEVEDO HEARING AND RULING

Groom CONCEPCION QUEVEDO failed to appear this morning for a schedule hearing (case number 12HP0004). The complaint was filed against him pursuant to a narcotics related arrest. He was suspended in the following ruling:

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900 (Grounds for Revocation or Suspension), groom **CONCEPCION QUEVEDO**, having failed to appear to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489(h)(Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License-possession of narcotics for sale), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Concepcion Quevedo are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Quevedo is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
