The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Cassidy accepted responsibility for failure to have his horse on the van in a timely manner for the trip over to Hollywood Park.

RULING HRTH #022

Exercise rider **JOSE ARIEL BECA** is fined **ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting-exercising a horse while the horse ambulance was on the track).

This ruling was issued after Mr. Beca admitted that he worked a horse while the horse ambulance was on the track at Santa Anita a few days ago. He said he would be more alert in the future.
