FLORES RULINGS

Pursuant to our informal hearing yesterday with apprentice jockey ESWAN FLORES, we issued two rulings. The first was for failing to meet with us on the appropriate day and the second was for a whip violation:

HRTH #068

Apprentice jockey **ESWAN FLORES** is fined **ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers-failure to meet with the Stewards as directed).

(amended)HRTH #070

Apprentice jockey **ESWAN FLORES** is fined **THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips-hitting his mount after the wire) following the running of the first race at Betfair Hollywood Park on July 4, 2012.

GARCIA HEARING

We held an informal hearing this morning into case number 12HP064 which was a financial complaint filed by trainer DAVID YOUNG against his former owner ALFONSO GARCIA. The complaint alleged that Mr. Garcia had failed to pay for workers' compensation insurance charged per start. We felt that this expense was the trainer's responsibility and that the expenses were outside the year as permitted under the rule. The complaint was therefore dismissed.

Although the interference he caused was minor, we warned him that a straight path is always advisable.

Dr. Amy Seim withdrew her financial complaint (case number 12HP0068) against trainer GUS HEADLEY when Mr. Headley paid the alleged balance.

O'NEILL RULING

Trainer DOUG O'NEILL was fined in the following ruling when he accidentally medicated one of his runners, preventing that horse from running:

Trainer **DOUG O'NEILL** whose horse "Et Tu Walker" was scheduled to start in the sixth race at Betfair Hollywood Park on July 8, 2012, is fined **FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run-medication administration) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration).

STRA RULING

After a formal hearing (pursuant to a remand from Sacramento) the ruling against jockey KAYLA STRA was re-issued:

Pursuant to a formal hearing, jockey **KAYLA STRA** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for failure to fulfill her riding engagement in the second race at Betfair Hollywood Park on May 19, 2012, resulting in a late declaration. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

Jockey CHANTAL SUTHERLAND was in the office to review Saturday's fifth race, during which she came over approaching the far turn causing the horses inside to steady slightly. We felt she could have waited a couple more strides before dropping into the far turn. She agreed with our assessment and acknowledged her mistake. We felt the incident did not warrant a penalty. Ms. Sutherland was issued a warning.

STEWARDS' INQUIRY

Immediately after the running of the second race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start when #9 Our Trooper lost his rider (Vinnie Bednar). After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing the films we made no change to the original order of the finish. In our opinion, the apprentice lost his balance and came off on his own. Therefore, no change was made. Accident report attached.

BROKEN REIN

During the eighth race (turf) Jockey Aaron Gryder noticed his inside rein had broken going into the first turn. Mr. Gryder quickly handled the situation like a true veteran by grabbing the harness of the bridle and guiding him to the outrider to be pulled up. Both rider and horse (#6 Gurnick) escaped unharmed.
