GAINES MOTIONS

The Gaines hearings (case numbers 12DM0014, 0015, 0051, 0052) continued today with additional prehearing arguments on motions. Counsel for Gaines and Harris requested discovery that the CHRB maintained was not required under the California Administrative Procedures Act. Respondents then made a motion to compel the remaining discovery. Last week, we ruled that the standard for whether discovery was proper would be viewed through Chapter 5 of the APA. The purpose of today's hearing was to determine what additional discovery requests would be compelled. Both parties made arguments concerning each of the remaining discovery requests. Rulings will be made next Thursday during a telephonic hearing (on the record) with both counsels.

HENDRICKS RULING

The following ruling was issued when trainer DAN HENDRICKS brought a horse to the receiving barn that was improperly shod (his second time in the past year):

HRTH #014

Trainer **DAN L. HENDRICKS** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530(Cases Not Covered by Ruled and Regulations) for failure to have his horse "Hout Bay" properly shod for the second race at Betfair Hollywood Park on December 6, 2012.

O'NEILL RULING

The following ruling was published when Mr. O'Neill's veterinarian called the Official Veterinarian with a concern that on "in today" runner had been treated with procaine penicillin 17 days ago. While there is a provision for distinguishing procaine penicillin from other procaine, part of that protection requires six hour prerace surveillance which didn't occur in this case. While the medical professionals' opinion was that 17 days should be sufficient withdrawal time, we informed Mr. O'Neill that should a positive occur, he could not avail himself of the penicillin protection because he had not complied with the provisions. He chose to scratch the horse and accept the following penalty for late declaration:

HRTH #015

Trainer **DOUG O'NEILL** is fined **FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)*** pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Late Declaration-penicillin administration) for failure to start the horse "Hold'em Hustler" in the second race at Betfair Hollywood Park on December 7, 2012.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the second race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine an incident in which #1 Marv (T. Baze, jockey) took up along the rail during the stretch run. Films revealed that the eventual winner #4 Anythingscookin (A. Bisono, jockey) may have come in slightly, but it was the majority's opinion that Mr. Baze drove into a spot without sufficient room. Steward Sawyer's assessment was that there was sufficient room for Mr. Baze, but that he was not cost the opportunity at a better placing. However, we unanimously voted to make no change to the original finish after speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved.
