CHATTONG FORMAL HEARING CASE#12PM017

This complaint was filed by the CHRB for a violation of CHRB rules 1489 (a)(Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and 1902 (b) (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing). In attendance for the hearing were Investigator Jim Hamilton representing the CHRB, attorney Suzanne Porrizzo, respondent, owner Vichien Chattong and court reporter Michelle Dierig documented the proceedings. Mr. Chattong was convicted of five counts of violating Penal Code section 597(B), Cruelty to Animals, a felony, case #MA05708801. Mr. Chattong was sentenced to three years

of formal probation, thirty days of Community Labor and sixteen sessions of Animal Neglect Counseling. He was also ordered, “not to own, use or possess any dangerous or deadly weapons, including any firearms, knives and other weapons”, and “ordered not to own or possess any animals during the period of probation”. The complaint packet was entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. The following ruling was issued:

HRTH #002

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900(Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), Owner Vichien Chattong is suspended for the term of his license (May 31, 2015) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule#1489(a)(Convicted of a crime of moral turpitude-California Penal Code 597(b) Crimes Against Animals) and #1902(b)(Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing). During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of Vichien Chattong are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Chattong is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
