We issued the following ruling after jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA rode more than one designated yesterday on California-bred Gold Rush day:

**HRTH #003**

Jockey **VICTOR ESPINOZA** is suspended for ONE (1) additional RACING DAY (May 3, 2013) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766(f)(Designated Races-participated in more than one designated race on April 27, 2013).

**SMITH RULING**

The following ruling was issued when jockey MIKE SMITH missed a mount when he left town unexpectedly to work a horse in Kentucky:

**HRTH #004**

Jockey **MIKE SMITH** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\*** for failure to fulfill his riding engagement in the fourth race at Betfair Hollywood Park on April 26, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

**MADERA/EQUINE MEDICAL SETTLEMENT**

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Orlando Mojica came to the office this morning to represent JULIAN LEPAROUX for his ride in the eighth race on Sunday. Films revealed that he pushed his way out, moving and bumping two horses to his outside, as the field turned into the stretch. We felt this rose to the level of careless riding and therefore issued the following ruling:

**HRTH #007**

Jockey **JULIEN LEPAROUX** is suspended for **THREE (3) RACING DAYS** (May 12, 16, and 17, 2013) for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference while riding "Long Face" in the eighth race at Betfair Hollywood Park on April 28, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699(Careless Riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

**AGUILAR RULING**

The following ruling was issued after GRADED STAKES SECURITY personnel ERICK AGUILAR failed to appear for the continuation of his complaint (case number 13SA109 – felony conviction for worker’s comp fraud):

**HRTH #005**

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900(Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), the license of Graded Stakes Security Guard **ERICK AGUILAR** is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule#1489(h)(Grounds for Denial or Refusal of license-Workman’s Compensation fraud).

During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of Erick Aguilar are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Aguilar is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**APPRENTICE JOCKEY NICOLAS GONZOLO**

Prospective apprentice jockey NICOLAS GONZOLA came to the office this morning seeking a license. He is named on a horse at Los Alamitos tomorrow night. We didn’t think it prudent to issue an apprentice license to a rider making his first start at another track (much less a bull ring) and therefore sent him to Stewards at Los Al.

**BRYTON RACING RULING**

Owner KEVIN BRYAR (dba Bryton Racing) was suspended when he failed to appear to answer a complaint (case 13SA117) which was a financial complaint filed by trainer Jerry Quinn alleging unpaid training expenses:

Owner **KEVIN BRYAR (dba BRYTON RACING, LLC)**, having failed to appear to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-Jeremiah “Jerry” Quinn \$22,655.73).

During term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Kevin Bryar are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Bryar is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
