JOCKEY OBJECTION/FIFTH RACE (5/8-cushion)/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the race jockey David Flores, who rode #9 Catalina Bonita(2nd), lodged a claim of foul against #4 Harlington's Rose (T. Baze1st) for an incident inside the 1/16 marker. In late stretch #4 stepped out when passing #9, initiating contact. After a review of the videos, conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand. In the Stewards opinion, the incident did not alter the order of finish.

INQUIRY/SEVENTH RACE (3/4-cushion)/NO CHANGE

After the finish of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in the middle of the turn. Involved were #5 Declassify (M. Garcia 1st) and #3 Gonna Fly Now (J. Talamo 2nd). The videos verified that #5 did tighten up the hole on the fence causing #3 to steady. After talking with the Patrol Judges and both riders involved, it was unanimous decision that the incident did not cost #3 the opportunity of a better placing and the race was made official. The winning margin was 7 1/2 lengths.
