Mr. Garcia shifted in at the quarter pole causing jockey Joe Talamo to steady. He acknowledged that he did cross over slightly. However, the inside horse contributed by making contact with his hind quarters causing him to angle in. Stewards Tom Ward and Kim Sawyer felt the video was inconclusive and failed to show a good angle of the incident. Therefore, Mr. Garcia was issued a warning. Steward Luis Jauregui felt the incident did warrant a three day suspension.

HELLUM HEARING

Owner LANCE HELLUM appeared in a formal hearing (case number 13HP0007) to answer a complaint filed by the CHRB alleging several rule violations concerning a trainer's test. Mr. Hellum admitted that after failing the written trainer's test, consulting with Safety Steward Luis Jaurgeui and this Board, and being informed that he must wait 30 days before taking the test, he went to Los Alamitos and retook the exact same test there. He was candid about his mistake. Unfortunately, he may have a larger problem in that his license was conditional and could be suspended based on any rule violations. Evidence was taken and the record was closed. Decision to follow.

TYLER BAZE ISSUE

The CHRB investigative staff met with jockey TYLER BAZE this morning as they do every day he rides or exercises horses. Suspecting alcohol usage, they required him to submit to a breathalyzer test. The test revealed a BAL and the CHRB informed this Board. We met with Mr. Baze and his agent as well as the CHRB. Mr. Baze was taken off of his

mounts for violation of his conditional license agreement and will remain so pending a formal hearing into the matter.

Fortunately, the interference occurred right before the wire so an inquiry or change was not necessary. The majority felt that Mr. Bisono’s record allowed for a warning but Steward Chaney voted for a three day suspension.

MODE HEARING

Trainer EMILY MODE appeared by telephone to answer case number 13HP031 which involved parking tickets at Santa Anita. While she admitted to the violations (not her first), she felt that she was being singled out by security. We issued the following ruling:

HRTH #027

Trainer **EMILY MODE** is fined **ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers-2nd offense) on May 2, 2013.

HUYANH RULING

Exercise DUNG HUYNH was suspended when he failed to appear for a hearing (case number 13SA124) based on a drug conviction:

HRTH #028

Exercise rider **DUNG THANH “Jimmy” HUYNH**, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489(h)(Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License-possession of a controlled substance), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547(Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Dung Huynh are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Huynh is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

MIKUS HEARING

We held a formal hearing into case number 13HP018 which was a formal hearing involving a bute overage uncovered in one of trainer LINDA MIKUS' runners. She was eligible for and received a warning.

SHERLOCK HEARING

We held a formal hearing into case number 13HP0012 which was a formal hearing involving a bute overage uncovered in one of trainer GARY SHERLOCK's runners. He was eligible for and received a warning.

RESCINDED CLAIM

Following the running of the third race, we were informed by the paymaster that there was a potential irregularity with one of the claims in for the winner, #1 Streets of Heaven. That horse had two claims in for him, both under trainer Jorge Periban. The two ownerships were SAY Racing and 702 Farms. The original owner was James Shenouda, who we learned was partners in several horses with 702 Farms. We rescinded the 702 Farms claim and let the SAY Racing (a completely separate interest) stand because the horse was still in the receiving barn for testing. The matter was referred to the CHRB for investigation.

This formal hearing was scheduled as the first of two involving a situation in which the CHRB was alleging that a private veterinarian was prescribing injectable medications to a massage therapist who was administering them herself to horses in the stable area. Prior to the hearing for veterinary assistant/massage therapist ALINA MILAN (case number 13SA118), her attorney negotiated a stipulated agreement with the CHRB investigative staff. The stewards approved the agreement and we will issue a ruling memorializing said agreement tomorrow.
