PEDROZA RULING

We issued the following ruling after jockey MARTIN PEDROZA rode two designated races while on suspension:

HRTH #001

Jockey **MARTIN PEDROZA** is suspended for **ONE** additional (**1**) **RACING DAY** (November 9, 2013) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (f) (Designated Races-participated in more than one designated race on November 2, 2013).

MOLINA RULING

Assistant trainer MARK MOLINA was suspended in the following ruling when he failed to comply with the terms of a signed financial agreement:

HRTH #002

Assistant trainer **MARK MOLINA** is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-owner Frank Bodell-\$10,000.00).

During term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Mark Molina are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Molina is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

DELGADILLO RULING

Jockey AGAPITO DELGADILLO was issued the following ruling after an unsuccessful appeal of a riding suspension from Del Mar:

HRTH #003

Jockey **AGAPITO DELGADILLO**, having lost his appeal of Ruling #DMTD 008, issued at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on July 24, 2013, is suspended for **THREE (3) RACING DAYS** (November 10, 11, and 15, 2013). All other terms of the original ruling shall remain in effect.

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

MURRAY REINSTATEMENT

Having satisfied the alleged training debt to trainer Ted West, Owner JAMES MURRAY was reinstated in the following ruling:

HRTH #004

Owner **JAMES MURRAY**, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-Ted West \$2,000.00) is restored to good standing. Ruling LATS #013, issued at Santa Anita Race Track on October 5, 2013, is set aside.

COMPLAINT WITHDRAWN

H.E. (Tex) Sutton Forwarding Co withdrew its complaint (case number 13SA192) against trainer CODY AUTREY alleging unpaid shipping bill after the debt was paid.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGES

Following the running of the third race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine an incident in the first turn where #1 Thunder Cole (M. Gutierrez) appeared to duck into and make contact with the inner rail. Films seemed to indicate that the horse reacted to close quarters and Mr. Gutierrez felt that the horse to his outside contributed to the pressure. Although we didn't entirely agree with his assessment, the point was moot because that horse finished behind #1. We unanimously voted to make no change.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGES

Following the running of the seventh race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine an incident near the 5/16ths pole in which #1 Warren's Flasher steadied and clipped heels. Films revealed that the horses slowed down a bit in front of jockey Brice Blanc, who was unable to prevent his mount from running up on heels. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, and since #1 caused her own problems, we unanimously determined that no change was appropriate.

Jockey FERNANDO PEREZ came to the office to review his ride in the first race yesterday in which he allowed his mount to drift in front of a rival during the stretch run, while not completely clear. We warned him that he must be more careful and aware, and he left the office with a warning.

MUNOZ RULING

After considering the evidence heard at the hearing at Santa Anita in the wage dispute between trainer BRUCE HEADLEY and groom MARTIN MUNOZ, we issued the following ruling:

HRTH #005

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), based upon the Labor Commission's findings as well as the evidence at hearing, trainer **BRUCE HEADLEY** is not indebted to groom **MARTIN MUNOZ** for unpaid wages.

URBINA HEARING

After considering the evidence heard at the formal hearing at Santa Anita involving pony rider/gateman LEO URBINA and the alleged poor care of a pony:

HRTH #006

Gateman **LEO URBINA** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare – care of pony). Mr. Urbina is further prohibited from holding a California Horse Racing Board license in a license category requiring direct contact with horses for a period of two years from the date of this ruling.

COMPLAINTS WITHDRAWN

The following financial complaints were withdrawn when the alleged debts were paid in full: veterinarian Dr. Nolton Patio against owner JAMES OLIVER (case number 13SA181) and owner IRENE FESS (case number 13SA180); pony rider Jesus Aguirre against ANGEL RODRIGUEZ (case number 13SA184); and veterinarian Dr. John Araujo against owner DULCE WOOD (case number 13SA188) and owner NICHOLAS YERTON (case number 13SA170).

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the second race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine two incidents during the running of the race. First, at the top of the stretch, #5 Zip Cat (second place finisher, F. Martinez) bolted out sharply and forced #6 Guidopanzini (winner, L. Medina) to steady and go wide. No other horses suffered interference and since #6 won the race, no change was necessary. Second, the eventual winner crossed over in front of fourth place finisher #4 Private Bounty, causing that rider to steady approaching the sixteenth pole. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish. In our view, #4 did suffer interference but was not cost the opportunity at a better placing.

LOOSE HORSE/DELAY

Just before the start of the sixth race, #7 Ashley's Bambino broke through the starting gate, injured the assistant starter and lost her rider. She caused a significant delay after running around the turf course and then infield before being corralled by the outriders. The incident caused an 18 minute delay to the start of the race.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign after the eighth race to examine an incident during the stretch run. Films showed that the fifth place finisher (#2 Costamar, E. Maldonado) steadied sharply along the rail near the eighth pole, as the eventual winner #10 Savings Account (M. Smith) passed and drifted in. However, we unanimously voted to make no change because #2 was drifting out and there was always sufficient room along the inner rail.

FILM REVIEW

Apprentice jockey IRVING OROZCO came to the office this morning to review his ride in the seventh race yesterday. We felt that he was too aggressive while turning into the stretch and driving on the inside of two horses. In the process he floated the horses out and made it extremely tight among the three rivals causing the horse in the middle to check. He left the office with a warning (Steward Sawyer voted for three suspension days).

Jockey LUIS MEDINA came to the office to review his ride in the second race yesterday. The subject of an inquiry, he guided his horse to the inside while not clear of a rival, who checked. The majority issued a warning while Steward Chaney voted for three suspension days.

CONTRERAS HEARING

Case number 13SA191 was withdrawn when trainer GERARDO CONTRERAS returned a pony to exercise rider Miguel Michel. Mr. Mitchel who was claimed that Mr. Contreras never paid for the horse pursuant their sale agreement.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the third race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine an incident at the five sixteenths pole in which jockey David Flores steadied his mount sharply. Films revealed that the two possible causes were horses that finished behind Mr. Flores' mount and therefore we unanimously determined that no change was appropriate. The riders of the two horses will be called in to sort out culpability.
