#### FILM REVIEW

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race on Thursday. We felt that he was too aggressive in trying to split horses with insufficient clearance between them. He agreed.

Jockey CHANTAL SUTHERLAND came to the office to discuss her ride in the fifth race on Friday during which her mount shifted out in the stretch. While it was a sudden move, we felt that she hit her mount twice in rapid succession, and could have corrected the move more quickly. She pledged to do a better job in the future.

#### CROSS COMPLAINTS

We held an informal hearing into two complaints filed by the CHRB: (1) exercise rider EDWIN "FAST EDDIE" VARGAS filed a financial complaint (case number 13SA190) against trainer GEORGE PAPAPRODRMOU and (2) trainer GEORGE PAPAPRODRMOU filed a disorderly conduct/harassment complaint (case number 13HP075) against Mr. Vargas. Mr. Vargas couldn't produce a record of the mounts he rode for the trainer, and the trainer's complaint seemed a bit thin against Mr. Vargas. Therefore both complaints were dismissed.

**HARRINGTON HEARING**

We held a formal hearing into two complaints (case numbers 13SA137 and 13SA143) the CHRB filed against trainer MIKE HARRINGTON for alleged bute overages discovered in the post race sample of two different runners on the same day. We heard oral testimony from Dr. Harrington and admitted documentary evidence from the CHRB. Given the levels, the licensee's history and absent any recommendation by the CHRB investigative staff, the majority opted to combine the positives (since they occurred on the same day) and issued Dr. Harrington a warning pursuant to the penalty guidelines. Steward Chaney voted for a warning and a \$250 fine for the positives.

**AVILA RULING**

Pursuant to the formal hearing we held yesterday, we issued the following ruling:

**HRTH #018**

Trainer **Antonio "A. C." Avila**, who worked the horse "NONNA REESE" on September 17, 2013, for removal from the Veterinarian's List, is fined **SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)\*** pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a)(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843(a)(d) (Medication, Drugs, and Other Substances), #1844(c)(1)(Authorized Medication-Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level – 3.7 ug/ml-3<sup>rd</sup> offense), and #1866(d)(Veterinarian's List).

**FRIDAY**11/29/13<sup>1</sup>**SUSPENSION IMPOSED AGAIN**

Jockey EDWIN MALONADO appealed a 3 day suspension issued at Del Mar. The administrative law judge affirmed our decision which was then adopted by the Board. The matter was remanded to us for the re-imposition of days, which was memorialized in the following ruling:

**HRTH #021**

Jockey **EDWIN MALDONADO**, having lost his appeal of Ruling DMTD #036, issued at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on August 15, 2013, is suspended for **THREE (3) RACING DAYS (December 5, 6, and 7, 2013)**. All other terms of the original ruling shall remain in effect.

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766(Designated Races).
